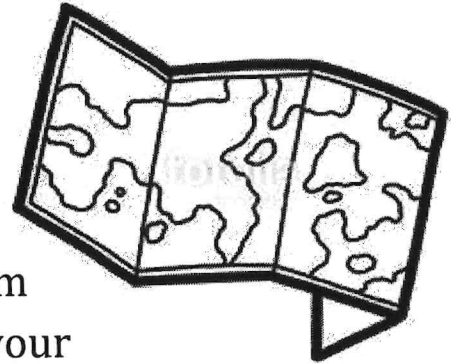

## Road Map Book Report

For this book report you will create a time-line in the shape of a road map. The road map will show important events from a particular period in history covered in your book in sequential order.

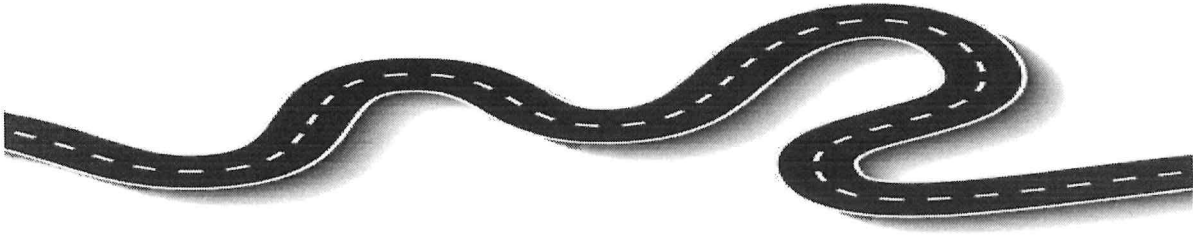
- Check off each requirement after you've completed it.

### Requirements:

- DESIGNING THE ROAD
  - 1. Use a piece of white construction paper (12x18 inches).
  - 2. Design a road on this white paper that has a beginning and an end.
  - 3. This road could be a winding country road, a busy downtown street, a superhighway, or a design of your choice.
  - 4. Use a pencil when designing your road in case you need to make changes.
- DESIGNING THE STOPS

Once you have designed your road, add **ten** “stops” along the way. These stops can be:

- traffic lights
- stop signs
- yield signs
- street names
- bridges
- exit ramps
- detours
- toll booths



- **ADDING THE INFORMATION**

- 1. At each stop (starting with stop 1), write the title and date of event 1.
- 2. Under the title of the stop, write two complete sentences that explain the event.
- 3. Continue along your stops, adding events in sequential order as you move along the road.
- 4. Make sure you have clearly marked a beginning and an end to your road map.
- 5. Add small icons (pictures) next to each stop that relate to that event.

- **FINISHING TOUCHES**

- 1. Create a title for your road map (example: Road Map to the Revolutionary War). Use creative lettering.
- 2. Add landscaping to your design to fill up empty spaces.
- 3. Color all pictures, roads, landscaping, and your title.
- 4. Use a fine black marker to trace over all writing.
- 5. Erase all pencil lines.
