Between April 2020 and March 2022, OCSP funded **136** Meals on Wheels and other organizations across Ontario.

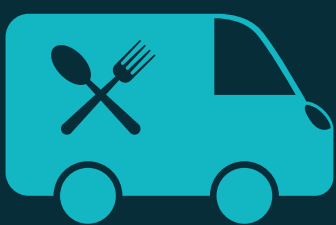
