# Keeping Vulnerable Ontarians Safe & Independent at Home During the Pandemic



Between April 2020 and March 2022, OCSP funded **136** Meals on Wheels and other organizations across Ontario.

OCSP funds helped them meet demand increases of up to **46%** at the height of the crisis.
