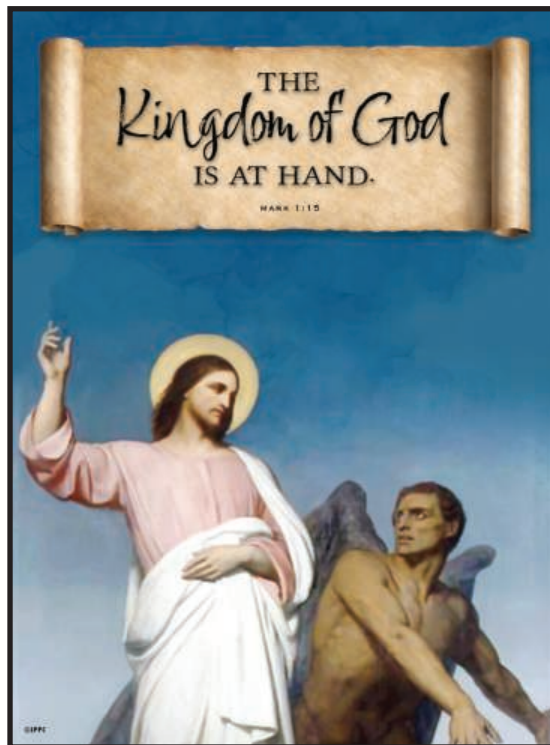

# Pastor's Reflection

## First week of Lent The Temptation in the Desert

Next Saturday morning, from 9:30 to noon, Fr. Tom Scirghi, S.J., of Fordham University, will offer a presentation on the Liturgy. I strongly urge all to attend. Fr. Scirghi is a very engaging speaker, and his sessions will build on the work done with the liturgical ministers in November.

The presentation will be in two parts. The first is The Liturgy: The Work of the People for God. In preparation he invites us to read *Sacrosanctum Concilium* ("The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy,") nn. 1-57. (chapters 1 and 2) ([https://www.vatican.va/archive/hist\\_councils/ii\\_vatican\\_council/documents/vat-t\\_19631204\\_sacrosanctum-concilium\\_en.html](https://www.vatican.va/archive/hist_councils/ii_vatican_council/documents/vat-t_19631204_sacrosanctum-concilium_en.html)). This is the 60th anniversary of that document which chartered the course of post-Vatican II liturgical renewal.

The second session is entitled The Eucharist: Our Thanksgiving to God. Fr. Scirghi will explore the meaning of "Real Presence" and connect it to the upcoming diocesan "Eucharistic Renewal." This will be followed by a Q & A period.

This very important morning will help us ponder ways we can enhance our own spiritual preparation for participating in liturgy. Are we a thanks-giving people? Does mass influence our prayer and deeds throughout the week? How do actions of mass shape Christian life? What about objects, words, postures and gestures? What good habits would prepare us to participate more fully in Sunday mass? How can we invite more people to join us in liturgical ministry?

This will be the second of our Lenten Saturday morning programs. Each begins immediately after the 9:00 a.m. mass. Even if you cannot attend any of the other presentations (cf. the bulletin, website and email blast for details) please come to this one. It will help us take the next steps in liturgical renewal in our parish.

Almost 2000 years ago, a bishop wrote "Exhort the people to be faithful to the assembly of the Church. Let them not fail to attend, but let them gather faithfully together. Let no one deprive the Church by staying away; if they do, they deprive the Body of Christ of one of its members!" (*Didascalia*, chapter 13).

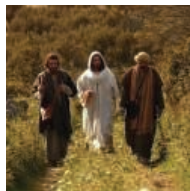

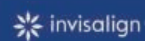
