Pastor's Reflection

Third Week of Lent: Woman at the Well

Three quick scenes from this long gospel:

First the Samaritan woman has to fetch water in the heat of the day. She can't go to the well with the other women of the village in the cool of the morning or dusk with the other women because they have branded her "a bad woman." That separation is emblematic of sin, which severs right relationship with God and with God's people. That is the opposite of Shalom, peace, which flows from God's loving mercy of the Covenant.

Second, Jesus risks his own reputation by talking to her. He is willing to pay a price for rescuing here, restoring her to community and to right relationship with God.

Third, after encountering Jesus, the woman becomes an evangelist, sharing the good news of the gift of living water. She leads others to their own encounter with Jesus.

We retell this story in Lent because it evokes baptism, the graces of which Lent renews in us; and we tell it at Eucharist because it evokes the price Christ pays—his body broken, his blood poured out—in order to restore union and communion with God. And it models for us our own mission: to go forth and share the Shalom we receive here with others so they too may encounter the same Jesus, drink deeply of his living water, and can come to declare: we believe, not just because of what you say, but because we have met him and come to know that he is the Christ."

"It joined us together, the well; the well led me into You.
No one between us but light deep in the well, the pupil of the eye, set in an orbit of stones.
Within your eye, I, drawn by the well, am enclosed. (Karol Wojtyla)

Next Saturday morning immediately after the 9:00 a.m. mass, we continue our Lenten series with an Ignatian meditation on the Man Born Blind. It will conclude with the sacrament of anointing of the sick. Please join us!

Family Stations of the Cross, March 29th at 6.00pm

Would your family like to take part in the family stations of the cross? It is a great way to get involved during Lent. We are looking for **children** who would like to read at each station and to be part of a powerful way to share in your faith, and enter into, the mystery of Jesus' gift of himself to us. Please contact Loren for more details.

Stations of the Cross is a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus' last day on earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.

If a Parish Isn't Crying, It's Dying. Silence has its place in church, but don't forget that 'God put the wiggle in children.'

My daughter began her preaching career at St. Michael's Church about 10 years ago. The only problem? A priest was delivering his homily at the same time.

As the priest offered his thoughts on the Gospel, my daughter, then 8 months old, shouted and smacked her hands on the back of the pew in front of her. It wasn't long before congregants turned around to find her flashing a mostly toothless smile. During such moments, all parents ponder the same question: At what point does my child become so disruptive that I need to escort her out?

On one occasion I was told "you know there is a cry room in the back." To which I responded, "I know, but my daughter's not crying." I was never one for the "cry room".

People approached my husband and I after Mass and, rather than offer veiled remarks about how "spirited" our child was, told us that our daughter was destined for the choir when she was older. 10 years on, she is an altar server and serves every Sunday without fail.

Silence has its place, and most parents try to keep their children quiet, a task that often requires ingenuity. I never thought I would spend most Sundays feeding my child Cheerios and crackers from my sweaty palms or urging them to keep quiet while helping them flip through a book or two, but that's what worked for that season. It doesn't always go according to plan, and many parents are tempted to rush out at the first squawk.

Pope Francis, who famously loves babies and has encouraged mothers to feel comfortable breastfeeding during Mass, seems to agree. In 2014 he said, "It really irritates me when I see a child crying in church, and someone says they must go out. God's voice is in a child's tears." Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me,"

"The presence of children is a gift to the Church, and they are a reminder that our parish is growing. Please welcome our children and give a smile of encouragement to their parents."

To parents of small children, if you leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. Everyone is welcome!
