

HOW DO WE DRESS FOR CHURCH AND IS IT APPROPRIATE?

Leviticus: 19:30 says: "You shall keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary: I am the LORD". To "revere" means "to regard with awe, great respect or devotion; honor." We worship God in spirit and truth.

Clothing & Worship are Inseparable.

If Christ were to decide to spend the day with you, would you dress any differently than normal? Would you rush out to buy new clothing? Maybe you would make sure you were dressed formally or make sure you dressed modestly? Maybe you would put on what the world calls its "Sunday best"? The Bible is filled with examples of how God's people dressed up to reverence God's sanctuary - to reverence His presence. They made a big deal out of this one important facet because, spiritually, the outward and the inward should agree and reflect our relationship with our God. In recent years, the fads have been dressing down and dressing to draw attention to the body. These things are perfectly acceptable in a society without understanding, but not in God's Church. An abysmal lack of training in dress, grooming and hygiene is the more we are around this thinking, the more we think it is normal. It is easy to think; What I am wearing is modest when I compare it to what the world around me is wearing. But too often it is still immodest compared to what the Church is teaching as modesty. We receive numerous complaints about what others think is inappropriate and, in some cases, they are justified. Are we competing with Jesus for attention by the way we dress? In general, we should look like we thought about our outfit, and it should be respectful and not draw the wrong attention. Please think about the way you and your children dress for church.






Adoration & Rosary


