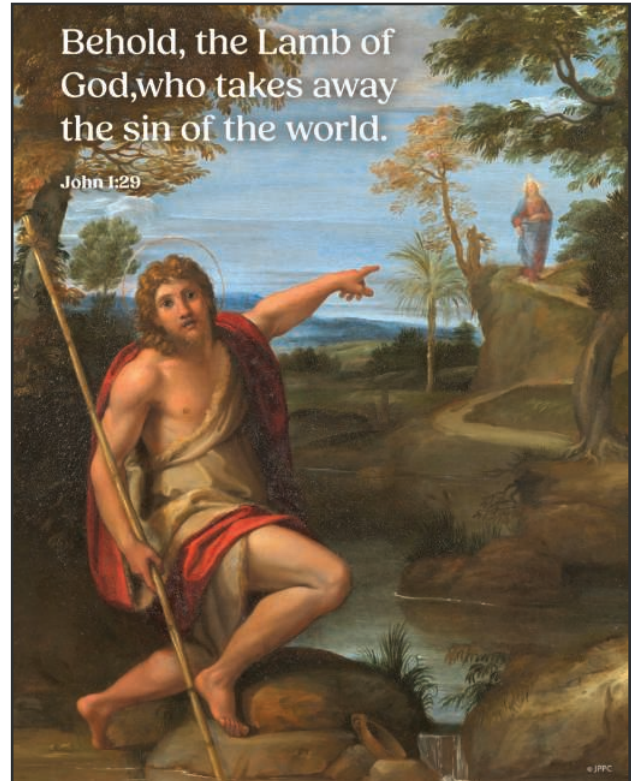

Pastor's Reflection

The next five Sundays (January 18 & 25, February 1, 8 and 15) are called "Ordinary Time" until we begin Lent on February 18th. Our challenge at liturgy, and in our life of discipleship as Christians, is that "ordinary" can become "routine" or even quotidian and pedestrian.

So for the next three weeks, in this space, I would like to reflect on one of the most ordinary things we do---receive Eucharist---with some considerations that might reinvigorate our appreciation of what we are saying and doing when we, as the Body of Christ, receive the Body of Christ.

I want to start with our bodily gestures for reception of holy communion: our procession to the altar, our participation in the music (the Antiphon that accompanies that procession), our gesture of reverence before receiving Eucharist, our response to the proclamation "Body of Christ" and our thanksgiving for communion. I'll take each of these in turn, so I invite you from the outset to keep all three of these reflections together. They will appear on the website under Bulletin.

The final two Sundays of Ordinary Time (February 8th and 15th) will then focus us on preparation for celebrating Lent.

The Church understands the Communion Procession, in fact every procession in liturgy, as a sign of the pilgrim Church, the body of those who believe in Christ, on their way to the Heavenly Jerusalem. All our lives we who believe in Christ are moving in time toward that moment when we will be taken by death from this world and enter into the joy of the Lord in the eternal Kingdom he has prepared for us. The liturgical assembly of the baptized that comes together for the celebration of the Eucharist is a witness to, a manifestation of, the pilgrim Church. When we move in procession, particularly the procession to receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Communion, we are a sign, a symbol of that pilgrim Church "on the way."

For some, however, the experience of the Communion Procession is far more prosaic, analogous perhaps to standing in line in the supermarket or at the motor vehicle bureau. A perception such as this is a dreadfully inaccurate and impoverished understanding of what is a significant religious action. The Communion Procession is an action of the Body of Christ. At Christ's invitation, extended by the priest acting in Christ's person: "Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb," the members of the community move forward to share in the sacred meal, to receive the Body and Blood of Christ which is the sign and the source of their unity.

In fact, each time we move forward together to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord, we join the countless ranks of all the baptized who have gone before us, our loved ones, the canonized and uncanonized saints down through the ages, who at their time in history formed a part of this mighty stream of believers.

Next week: the communion song and gesture of reverence.

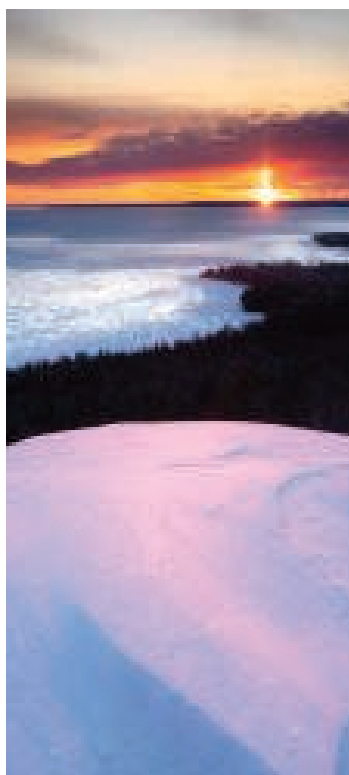

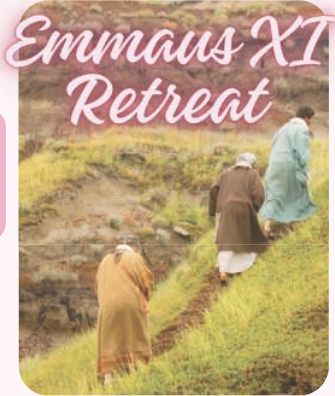
Once the form is submitted, you will hear from one of our bereavement ministers regarding the next steps.

Students have been preparing for this very moment for a long time, the moment they are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to them at baptism, by receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. On Friday, January 16th, we were joined by Bishop Frank Caggiano as 38 students received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
