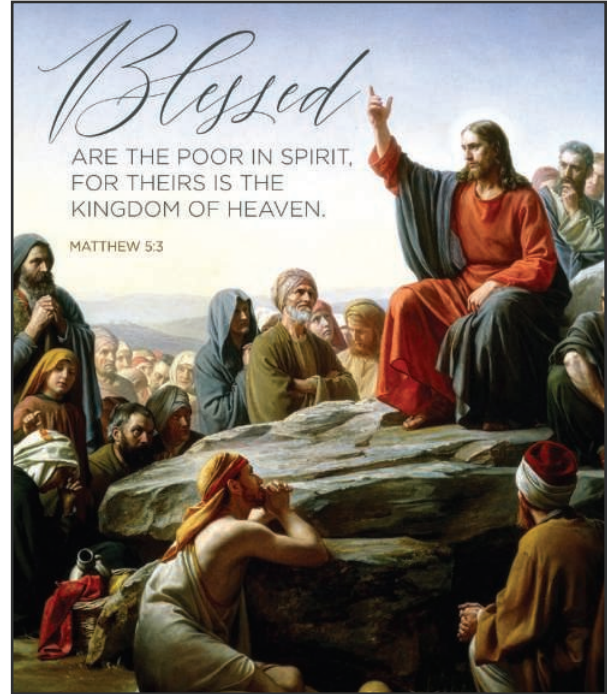

Pastor's Reflection

Last week, we noted the importance of participating in the communion song, expressing that reception of Eucharist is an act of communal worship rather than simply a personal piety.

The fact that the Communion Procession is a profoundly religious action tells us something about the way in which we should participate in this procession. We are the Body of Christ, moving forward to receive the Christ who makes us one with himself and with one another. Our procession should move with dignity; our bearing should be that of those who know they have been redeemed by Christ and are coming to receive their God!

The U.S./ Conference of Bishops has determined that "[t]he norm... is that Holy Communion is to be received standing, unless an individual member of the faithful wishes to receive Communion while kneeling" and that a bow is the act of reverence made by those receiving (no. 160).

Those who receive Communion may receive either in the hand or on the tongue.

If Communion is received in the hand, the hands should first of all be clean. If one is right-handed the left hand should rest upon the right. The host will then be laid in the palm of the left hand and then taken by the right hand to the mouth. If one is left-handed this is reversed. It is not appropriate to reach out with the fingers and take the host from the person distributing.

The person distributing Communion says audibly to each person approaching, "The Body of Christ." **This is a proclamation which calls for a response of faith on the part of the one who receives. The communicant should audibly respond, "Amen," indicating by that response his or her belief that this small wafer of bread, the wine in this chalice are in reality the body and blood of Christ the Lord.**

Let me conclude these reflection with a quotation from the [Catechism of the Catholic Church](#), no. 1396:

In Baptism we have been called to form but one body. The Eucharist fulfills this call: "The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread" (1 Cor 10:16-17).

If you are the body and members of Christ, then it is your sacrament that is placed on the table of the Lord; it is your sacrament that you receive. To that which you are you respond "Amen" ("yes, it is true!") and by responding to it you assent to it. For you hear the words, "the Body of Christ" and respond "Amen." Be then a member of the Body of Christ that your Amen may be true (St. Augustine, Sermon 272: PL 38, 1247).

Parish Safety Committee**

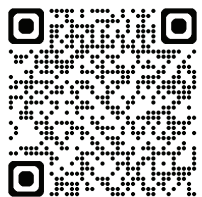

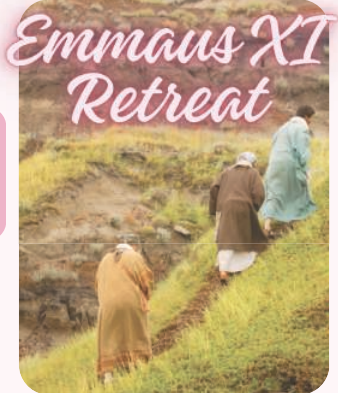

FAITH FORMATION

A lifelong journey, childhood-teens-adults

Baptism at St. Michael Church.

Passing on our faith begins at birth! It is because we love our children so much that we want to give them the very best. To really provide the best possible life for our children, it is necessary to teach them to have a relationship with God and the first step in doing that is getting your baby baptized.

The Church strongly recommends that baptisms “be celebrated ordinarily on Sunday(s) when the Church commemorates the Lord’s resurrection. Baptisms at St. Michael Church are celebrated during one of our Sunday Masses, so that the entire community may be present and the relationship between baptism and Eucharist may be clearly seen.” (Canons 856 and 867).

Since Lent is our “desert time” leading up to the water of baptism of the Elect at the Easter Vigil, and the renewal of our own baptismal promises, we do not celebrate baptisms during Lent (Feb 15 to April 5), unless the child is in imminent danger of death.

If you would like to arrange a baptism, please call the parish office at 203-869-5421. If this is your first baby, you will need to complete the Pre-Baptism class with our First Witness ministry.



Each of us has unique God-given gifts that we are called to share with others.

Here are some tips for helping your children find and follow God’s plan for their lives, and in doing, achieve true success:



1. With our young, tell them that God has a plan for their lives, & pray with them that they will discover this plan & live it.
2. Nurture a love for & knowledge of Sacred Scripture. Applying God’s revelation in Scripture to our own personal circumstances can be one starting point for discerning His will in our lives.
3. Help your children stay connected with the Christian community (parish family events, religious education, youth groups), so there will be other people in their lives who will encourage & point the way to God’s plan.
4. Invest in talents & interests shown by your child. Make sure he or she has the resources to bring a talent to its full potential. But be careful about pushing too far.
5. While you are nurturing your child’s interest in a particular area, be sure to encourage them to engage in other activities & explore new things as well.
6. Brainstorm with your children about ways to use their talents & interests to “give back” to others. Talents are meant to be shared. Where there is strength, there is also an opportunity for giving.

Becoming a Godparent or Confirmation sponsor? What is your role?...

The Godparent/sponsor’s role is to make sure that the person being baptized or Confirmed behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the duties inherent in these sacraments.”

A Godparent/sponsor has a great honor and responsibility to be a witness of Christ and help the baptized/Confirmed throughout their lifelong faith journey.
