

## Pastor's Reflection

His recognition was different. He hardly raised his eyes.

He was a great gathering of perception---  
Like the well blowing the brightness of water  
into a face.

He had a mirror--- like the well---shining deep,  
For him no need to come out of himself or raise his eyes to guess.  
He saw me in himself, possessed me in himself.  
He suffered me with ease,  
Burst my shame in me and the thoughts  
I'd suppressed for so long  
As if he---touching a rhythm in my temples---  
all of a sudden  
carried that great exhaustion  
in me, with such care.

He was whole in my sin and my secret.  
Such a shortcut, such goodness of perception!

## Your Lenten Almsgiving

Paul, (the Saint, not me the pastor!), characteristically begins his letters to the churches with a word of gratitude: "I give thanks to my God for all of you" (Rom. 1:8) and he considered the goal of his ministry to increase the amount of thanksgiving directed toward God: "Grace will come more abundantly upon you and great will be the thanksgiving for the glory of God." (2 Cor 4:15). In that light, Paul exhorts the community at Corinth: "Let each one give what he decided upon personally, and not reluctantly as if obliged. God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Cor 9:7.) As one of the three disciplines of Lent, along with prayer and fasting, Almsgiving then becomes intentional, joyful and **consistent**.

I too begin by expressing my gratitude for your generosity to the parish, to the annual Bishop's Appeal, and to the several extra collections like the Thanksgiving drive and the F.I.A.T. projects.

Our basic offertory collections, however, are **DOWN** compared to last year. Winter weather has significantly impacted Sunday mass attendance. We are kept solvent by generous one-time gifts and by our fundraisers, such as the Jubilee Gala and Golf Outing.

And we want to do more than just "stay afloat and keep the lights on." We want to flourish. And so, our parish operating budget and the twenty-five ministries it funds need **an Offertory supported by the entire parish community**.

Please prayerfully consider exercising **consistent stewardship**, even when you are out of town or the weather prevents your attending mass, by registering for **online giving** – see below for details –. Giving \$45 weekly, \$165 monthly or \$2,000 annually will underwrite St. Michael's **many ministries**, and our **one mission**, to give witness and service to the Reign of God, until God's "kingdom come and His will be done on earth as it is in heaven."





Family Stations of the Cross, Good Friday,  
**April 3rd at 6.00pm**

Would your family like to take part in the family stations of the cross? It is a great way to get involved during Lent. We are looking for **children** who would like to read at each station and to be part of a powerful way to share in their faith, and enter into, the mystery of Jesus' gift of himself to us. Stations of the Cross is a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus' last day on earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.
