Pastor's Reflection

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. In scripture, God's mercy is God's *hesed*, the loving kindness God extends to us, springing up from God's very nature, not from our merits or efforts. In particular, God begins to extend that *hesed* first in making Covenant with us, then bringing it to fullest expression in Christ's self-gift on the Cross. When the priest at the start of mass prays, "The grace and peace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God the Father be with you," he is invoking those three intertwined expressions of God's very nature—*hesed, shalom, ahava*, in Greek *charis, irene and agape*. (In passing, I note that a lot of the comments on-line about this Sunday focus on "how to earn a plenary indulgence," which shifts the focus from God's embrace of sinful humanity and onto our efforts to "merit" God's redemptive love.)

In her book, *Jesus the Compassion of God*, the late theologian Monica Helwig, wrote that compassion means "to suffer with," and asserted that such is the unique claim of Christianity: not just that God is in some volitional sense showing mercy towards sinful humans. Rather, in the Incarnation of Jesus, God suffers with us, enters into our dark moments, stands with us in the same agony and pain.

That compassion doesn't take away our pain; God's compassion doesn't minimize our pain; God's compassion doesn't distract us from it or anesthetize us to it. In God's compassion and mercy, God suffers *with us*.

Too often we resist getting near the suffering of another and sitting with them in their pain, partly out of fear, partly out of an unwillingness to suffer ourselves.

But Christ comes to enter into our pain, embrace it, and us, with outstretched arms, and draws us into His own Sacred Heart, pierced for our sake. And from there he begins to make possible our own love for one another, in imitation of His love and mercy for us. That love is a self-giving, self-sacrificing love, which flows from the love the Persons of the Trinity for one Another. The great gift of Divine Mercy is that we ourselves begin to become, as Henri Nouwen phrased it, "wounded healers."

Thomas Merton reminded us: "All the good you will do will not come from you but from the fact that you have allowed yourself, in the obedience of faith, to be used by God's love."

This becomes very practical and specific especially through intercessory prayer, which puts us in contact regularly both with God's compassionate mercy and with our wounded brothers and sisters. Such prayer helps us encounter each person as a brother, a sister, to be received and loved with a love implanted in us and already at work in the world.

Compassion, at least as exercised by us humans, isn't natural. On the contrary, it goes against the grain of our egoism, self-centeredness and self-protection. Only God, revealed in His Son Jesus the Christ, is truly so self-giving. That's because the very nature of the Trinity is the mutual self-giving of the Three Persons. Jesus enfleshes that compassion and mercy to open to each of us the same trajectory of self-gift, by His gift of mercy, His gift of Self to us. And only if you know that you are loved that much, cherished that much, worth that much, can you begin to love another in the same unconditional way.

Intercessory prayer of compassion roots us deeply in God and provides us the inner freedom to stand with others in their pain and not to flinch, not fix, not flee, but compassionate.

Blessed are all who know that they have received mercy; for they will become merciful. (cf. Matthew 5:7)

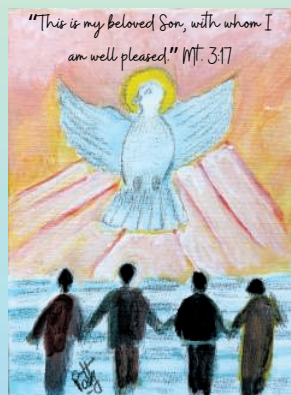

Your Lenten Almsgiving

Paul, (the Saint, not me the pastor!), characteristically begins his letters to the churches with a word of gratitude: “I give thanks to my God for all of you” (Rom. 1:8) and he considered the goal of his ministry to increase the amount of thanksgiving directed toward God: “Grace will come more abundantly upon you and great will be the thanksgiving for the glory of God.” (2 Cor 4:15). In that light, Paul exhorts the community at Corinth : “*Let each one give what he decided upon personally, and not reluctantly as if obliged. God loves a cheerful giver.*” (2 Cor 9:7.) As one of the three disciplines of Lent, along with prayer and fasting, Almsgiving then becomes intentional, joyful and consistent.

I too begin by expressing my gratitude for your generosity to the parish, to the annual Bishop’s Appeal, and to the several extra collections like the Thanksgiving drive and the F.I.A.T. projects.

Our basic offertory collections, however, are **DOWN** compared to last year. Winter weather has significantly impacted Sunday mass attendance. We are kept solvent by generous one-time gifts and by our fundraisers, such as the Jubilee Gala and Golf Outing.

And we want to do more than just “stay afloat and keep the lights on.” We want to flourish. And so, our parish operating budget and the twenty-five ministries it funds need an **Offertory supported by the entire parish community**.

Please prayerfully consider exercising **consistent stewardship**, even when you are out of town or the weather prevents your attending mass, by registering for **online giving** – see below for details –. Giving \$45 weekly, \$165 monthly or \$2,000 annually will underwrite St. Michael’s **many ministries**, and our **one mission**, to give witness and service to the Reign of God, until God’s “kingdom come and His will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”


