Thank You!

Among the great blessings of our Holy Week celebrations were the generous ministerial contributions of so many parishioners. The pastoral staff want to thank both those whose work was public and those whose efforts were “behind the scenes”:

- the members of the Liturgy committee, for assisting in the myriad of details that make up these Holy Week liturgies;
- the music ministry, who helped us “make a joyful sound to the Lord!”;
- lectors, especially those who assisted with the proclamation of the Passion Gospels on Palm Sunday and Good Friday and the multiple readings of the Easter Vigil;
- eucharistic ministers, especially during the Easter Sunday masses with their enormous crowds;
- acolytes, who helped with the good order and smooth running of these complex liturgies;
- those who helped on Holy Thursday, by having a foot washed, bearing the oils in the procession, stripping the altar, and setting up the altar of repose in the Holy Family room;

And finally, thank you to all who participated in Holy Week liturgies. Your presence, participation and prayer helped lift us up and carry us on deeper into the mystery of Christ’s dying and rising; and so with St. Paul, we “constantly give thanks for you to God the Father.... (and we are) certain that God who began the good work within you will continue that work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.” (Phil 1)

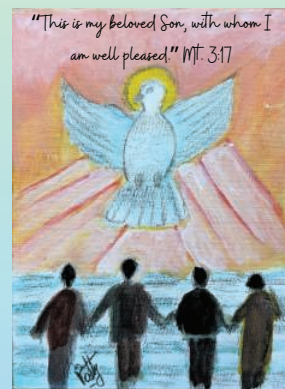


