Pastor's Reflection

"The Lord Jesus was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God."

These nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost mark the Church's first novena, when the disciples fervently prayed for the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to come upon them.

Sr. Joan Chittister OSB notes that "The other evangelists link the Ascension to Easter itself. But Luke has another lesson in mind. Jewish students studied with a rabbi "forty days," a symbolic number meaning the amount of time it took them to learn the master's teachings well enough to be able to repeat them. To Luke, then, the time after we experience the Resurrection may have less to do with Jesus than it does with us, with the centering of our minds and hearts on the world and the work at hand. To acknowledge the Resurrection, to be raised to a new understanding of Jesus ourselves, in other words, requires the fashioning of a life of contemplative awareness."

Lord God, you have glorified your Christ, exalting to your right hand the Son who emptied himself for us in obedience unto death on the cross; and thus you have exalted all of us who have been baptized into Christ's death and resurrection. Clothe us now with power from on high, that we may proclaim the good news to the world, confirming our message by the sign of our love for one another, and maintaining the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Gracious Father, you have promised to make your home with those who hear your word and put it into practice. Send your Spirit anew to remind our hearts of all that Jesus has taught us and to make us effective witnesses to your saving plan for all the world. Amen.

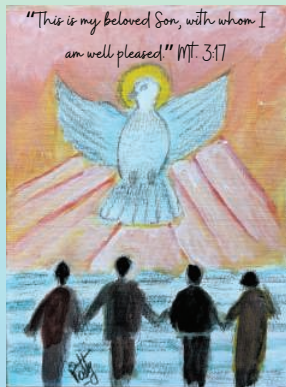

The Sacrament of First Eucharist – Keep the children of St. Michael in prayer as they continue to prepare to receive their sacrament.

The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith: it is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Pope Francis called it the "Sacrament of Love".

First Holy Communion is not simply a rite of passage. For children who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion, this is a big deal. And for all of us, no matter how many times we have received Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, **it should always be a big deal.**

Jesus comes to us in a unique way in the Eucharist. When He comes, we receive Him into our body and our soul. This is a very beautiful, personal, and intimate moment. We should not take it for granted!

This is why the first time a family member makes their Holy Communion; it is an exciting event for the whole family. The boy or girl preparing for this sacrament is going to be profoundly united with Jesus in a way that they never have before!

It is such a holy, joyful occasion. Our souls become the bride of Christ. That is why girls wear white dresses and boys wear suits. Relatives are invited. Parents take pictures. We celebrate together as a Church and as a community. **The very act of celebrating reveals our belief in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.**


