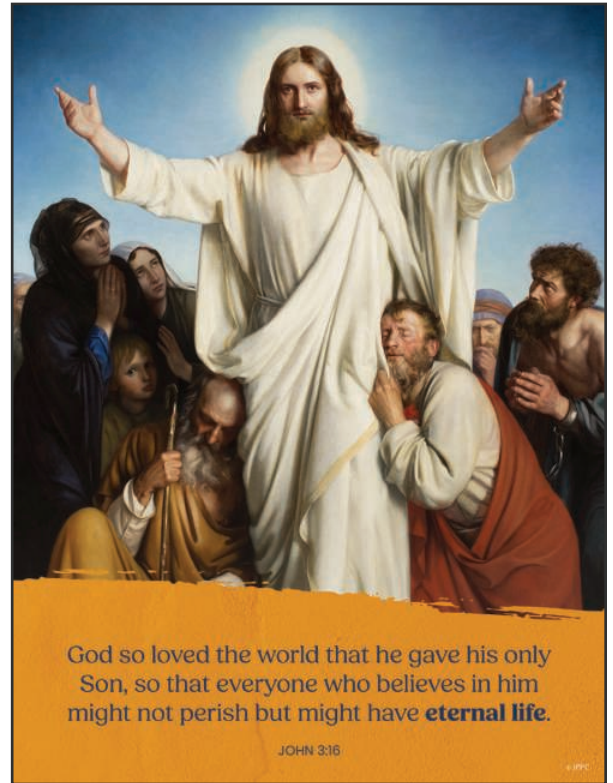

Pastor's Reflection

The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

"We could never have suspected that God is One and Three if God had not told us; and even after He told us, we cannot explain how this can be. But it is not light for the mind we seek; it is food for our spirit. And one way of lending meaning to the mystery is to steal St. John's definition of God: "God is Love" (1 Jn 4:8). In the Trinity we find the perfect realization of perfect love

What makes God God--we call it the divine nature--the Father has it completely, the Son has it completely, the Spirit has it completely. No one has anything the other does not have. The Father gives to the Son literally all that He Himself has, all that makes Him God, all that makes Him Love. And the Son is a perfect Son because He is the perfect image of His Father. The love with which the Son loves the Father is the selfsame infinite love with which the Father loves the Son. And this love of Father and Son, this love is the Holy Spirit. God is an eternal exchange of love.

The Trinity is the model for our return of love to God. Listen... to St. Augustine: "Are you looking for something to give to God? Give Him yourself." And in the Trinity, we find what ought to be our love for others. Like the divine Persons, each of whom remains fully Himself, without the Father becoming the Son or the Son becoming the Father, so we too have to be utterly and splendidly ourselves, develop ourselves with all the wealth God has given us. It is the only way we have of being useful to others, by bringing to them, in a gift of ourselves, what we alone can give them." (From Walter Burkhardt, S.J.)

Lord God, you so loved the world that you gave your only Son that all might be saved. Accompany us on our journey. Fashion our lives in your true image, so that we might embrace one another in the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, live in the communion of the Holy Spirit, and show forth your steadfast love and faithfulness that this world may see and believe.

Next week is the Feast of Corpus Christi, proclaiming our faith in Christ's real presence, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist. At the end of the 9:45 mass, we will have a Eucharistic procession (similar to Holy Thursday). We will process out of the church to the statue of the Holy Family (parking lot side), then around the back of church to the Cross (street side), then to the St. Michael statue, before reentering the church for Benediction and recitation of the Divine Praises. The procession is a sign that Christ walks with us, his pilgrim Church, as we move together "on the way" in time toward that moment when we will be taken by death from this world and enter into the joy of the Lord in the eternal Kingdom he prepares for us, the Supper of the Lamb.

This weekend, with the feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, we return to "Ordinary Time" and so to the recitation of the Nicene Creed. We used the Apostles' Creed throughout Lent and Easter because of its wording more closely expresses the words of our Easter renewal of our baptismal promises.

A creed is a summary statement of what is believed by the Church and its members. The Nicene Creed (more accurately the 'Constantinopolitan Creed') was formulated in 325 by the Council of Nicaea and later modified by the Council of Constantinople in 381 to the wording we have today.

The Nicene Creed has a different section for each person of the Trinity and the wording has been a source of tension in the church since first formulated. It was initially developed to stamp out the teaching of Arius, an Alexandrian priest who taught that Jesus was a created being and not present from the beginning as God was. Arius asserted that Jesus was human more than he was divine (which meant that he was not equal to God) as Arius wanted to uphold the Jewish teaching of monotheism (one God only). The Emperor Constantine established the Council of Nicaea to reject the teachings of Arius.

After the Council of Nicaea, further arguments arose among bishops about the divinity of Jesus and several different creeds developed. The words 'true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father' were included in 381.

In the eleventh century, the Western church added the words, 'and the Son' so the text then read, 'We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son'. This difference in creeds became a major source of tension between the Eastern and Western churches.


