## Pastor's Reflection

The Feast of Corpus Christi

“My flesh is true food and my blood is true drink.”

Today is the Feast of Corpus Christi, proclaiming our faith in Christ's real presence, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist. At the end of the 9:45 mass, we will have a Eucharistic procession (similar to Holy Thursday). We will process out of the church to the statue of the Holy Family (parking lot side), then around the back of church to the Cross (street side), then to the St. Michael statue, before reentering the church for Benediction and recitation of the Divine Praises. The procession is a sign that Christ walks with us, his pilgrim Church, as we move together “on the way” in time toward that moment when we will be taken by death from this world and enter into the joy of the Lord in the eternal Kingdom he prepares for us, the Supper of the Lamb.

Gracious God, at each Eucharist, you gather us together to tell the story anew of how you create us in your own image, redeem us by the blood of your son, and sanctify us through sharing your own spirit and life with us.

You open our eyes to glimpse your presence dwelling in Jesus of Nazareth, in one another, and in the breaking of the bread. With those new eyes, we gaze upon our world and our human family; we see the mystery of the inbreaking of your reign of justice and peace-making amidst the violence and sin of our world and of our own hearts. And we come to know that we are part of one another and of all of humanity.

Through this feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, we want to know this about ourselves more deeply. We want to see the Lord Jesus going before us, offering himself into the mystery of death, shaping us into his very own body by feeding us with his flesh and blood, and so touching the whole of the universe in ways beyond our imagining. He has made us part of himself, by becoming one of us.

Lord God, may this Feast of Corpus Christi draw us deeper into the Eucharist of our daily lives: the Eucharist of shared food and shared life, the Eucharist of shared benediction of our common creator and redeemer; the Eucharist of our common passage with the crucified and risen Jesus Christ, through death to eternal life. Amen.

## "June is bustin' out all over!" (Carousel)

The month of June traditionally is very busy. Many of you will be attending weddings and graduation ceremonies, and the St. Michael Parish family will also have much to celebrate.

Throughout the month several children will receive **Holy Eucharist for the first time.**

Beginning with the **Feast of Corpus Christi (June 7th)** we will extend the Cup at one mass each weekend: June 7 at noon, June 14 at 8 a.m., June 21 at 9:45 and Saturday June 27 at 5:15. If we can enlarge our cohort of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, we could extend the Cup at more liturgies.

**On June 7th** at the 9:45 a.m. mass we will have a Eucharistic Procession that will conclude with Benediction. All are encouraged to join us.

**On the weekend of June 13/14**, we will join all the other parishes of the Diocese of Bridgeport in a prayer of **Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus** at the end of Mass, and we will also **baptize three children.** The prayer of Consecration (see below) will be on a card each will receive that day.

**On Saturday July 18th** we will celebrate the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** at the 5:15 p.m. mass. All are welcome to avail themselves of the Sacrament, especially in conjunction of reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

**June 21st, Fathers' Day**, at each mass we will have a **special blessing and a gift** for the fathers in attendance.

## The Sacrament of First Eucharist

The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith: it is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Pope Francis called it the "Sacrament of Love".

First Eucharist is not simply a rite of passage. For children who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion, this is a big deal. And for all of us, no matter how many times we have received Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, **it should always be a big deal.**

Jesus comes to us in a unique way in the Eucharist. When He comes, we receive Him into our body and our soul. This is a very beautiful, personal, and intimate moment. We should not take it for granted!

This is why the first time a family member makes their Holy Communion; it is an exciting event for the whole family. The boy or girl preparing for this sacrament is going to be profoundly united with Jesus in a way that they never have before!

It is such a holy, joyful occasion. Our souls become the bride of Christ. That is why girls wear white dresses and boys wear suits. Relatives are invited. Parents take pictures. We celebrate together as a Church and as a community. **The very act of celebrating reveals our belief in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.**


