Pastor's Reflection

Friday, June 12th, was the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the Diocese will mark it with our prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart at each mass this weekend. We will distribute prayer cards and recite the text together.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus can be clearly traced back at least to the eleventh century. It marked the spirituality of Saint Bernard of Clairvaux in the twelfth century and of Saint Bonaventure and St Gertrude in the thirteenth. The beginnings of a devotion toward the love of God as symbolized by the heart of Jesus are found even in the fathers of the Church, including Origen, Ambrose, Jerome, Augustine, Hippolytus, Irenaeus, Justin Martyr and Cyprian.

The first liturgical feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated on 31 August 1670, in France. The devotion to the Sacred Heart spread widely following on the revelations to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. In June or July 1674, Sister Margaret Mary claimed that Jesus requested to be honored under the figure of His Heart, also saying that, when He appeared radiant with love, He asked for a devotion of expiatory love: frequent reception of Eucharist, especially on the first Friday of the month, and the observance of the Holy Hour. During the octave of Corpus Christi in 1675, probably on June 16, the vision known as the "great apparition" reportedly took place, where Jesus said: "Behold the Heart that has so loved men. ...Instead of gratitude I receive from the greater part (of humankind) only ingratitude," and asked Margaret Mary for a feast of reparation on the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi, bidding her consult her confessor Father Claude de la Colombiere, S.J.

Father de la Colombière directed her to write an account of the apparition, which he discreetly circulated in France and England. After his death in 1682, his journal of spiritual retreats was found to contain a copy in his handwriting of the account that he had requested of Margaret Mary, together with a few reflections on the usefulness of the devotion. This journal, including the account – an "offering" to the Sacred Heart in which the devotion was explained – was published at Lyon in 1684. The mission of propagating the new devotion was especially confided to the religious of the Visitation and to the priests of the Society of Jesus.

Since 2002, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is also a special Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests.

The month of June traditionally is very busy. Many of you will be attending weddings and graduation ceremonies, and the St. Michael Parish family will also have much to celebrate.

Throughout the month several children will receive **Holy Eucharist for the first time.**

Beginning with the **Feast of Corpus Christi (June 7th)** we will extend the Cup at one mass each weekend:, June 14 at 8 a.m., June 21 at 9:45 and Saturday, June 27 at 5:15. If we can enlarge our cohort of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, we could extend the Cup at more liturgies.

On the weekend of June 13/14, we will join all the other parishes of the Diocese of Bridgeport in a prayer of **Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus** at the end of Mass, and we will also **baptize three children**. The prayer of Consecration (see below) will be on a card each will receive that day.

June 21st, Fathers’ Day, at each mass we will have a **special blessing and a gift** for the fathers in attendance.

On Saturday, July 18th we will celebrate the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** at the 5:15 p.m. mass. All are welcome to avail themselves of the Sacrament, especially in conjunction of reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.


