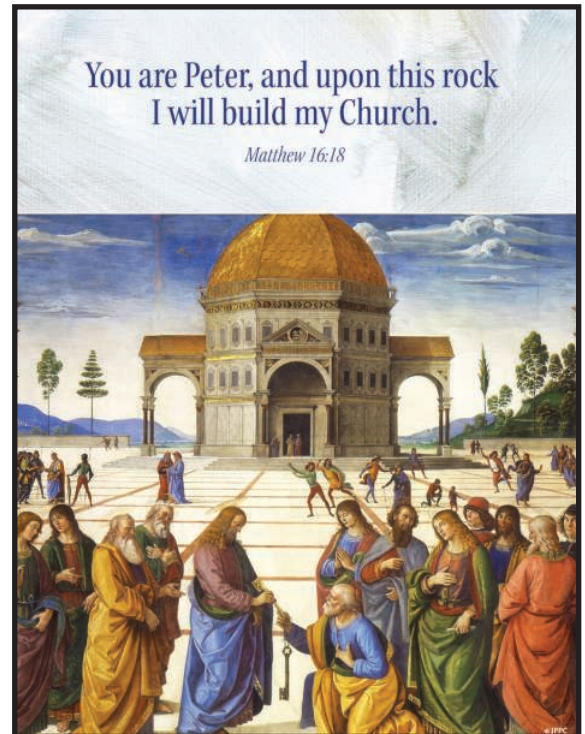

OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

Thank You

I am saddened to announce that as of this weekend, members of the Salesian community, who have faithfully and generously served St. Michael's and St. Timothy's for many years, will no longer be able to assist us.

Fr. Tom Brennan, SC, informed me that "we will have people transferred from our community leaving us unable to continue serving in all the parishes we have been assisting....We keep losing people each year as they are assigned elsewhere. The director decided that we have to cut back on the number of places we serve because over half of the people here now are frequently on the road and not able to help in the parishes." Tom then wrote of how much the Salesians have enjoyed their service with us and expressed their gratitude for the opportunity to serve us

On behalf of the parishioners of St. Michael's and St. Timothy's, I want to express our great gratitude for their ministry over many years.

Let me quote from a prayer of St. Francis de Sales, founder of their community, and ask that it be our own:

"Be at peace. Do not look forward in fear to the changes of life; rather, look to them with full hope as they arise. God, whose very own you are, will deliver you from out of them. He has kept you hitherto, and He will lead you safely through all things; and when you cannot stand it, God will bury you in his arms. Do not fear what may happen tomorrow; the same everlasting Father who cares for you today will take care of you then and every day. He will either shield you from suffering, or give you unfailing strength to bear it. Be at peace, then, and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations. Amen."

Murphy, Fr. Marcotte and myself, and the limited number of Fairfield Jesuits available during the summer.

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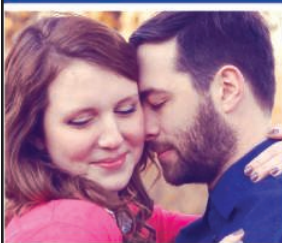
