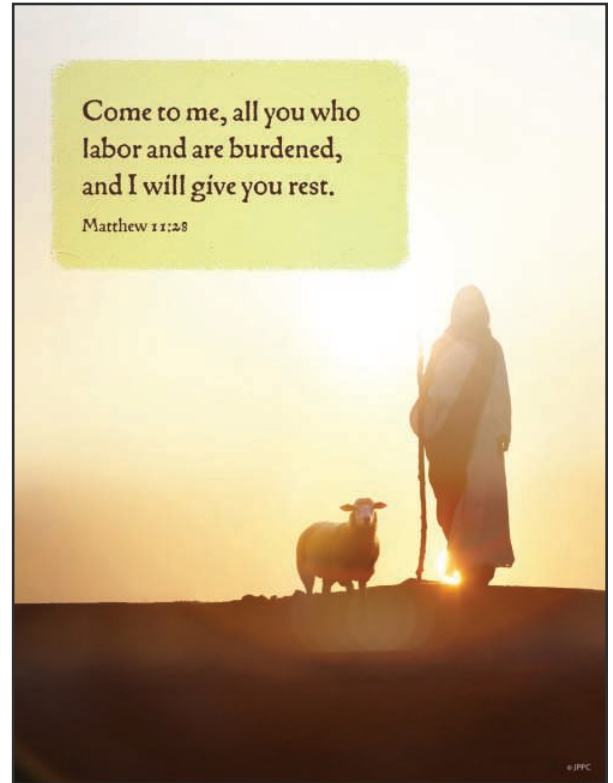

Pastor's Reflection

"Buried with Christ in baptism, we shall walk in the newness of life."

St. Paul stands in awe, that God has baptized us into the death of Christ and raised us up in Christ's Spirit, living for God in Christ Jesus. But we can take that "amazing grace" for granted. The Sign of the Cross can become routine and unthinking. Scripture, the very word of God, can become so much background noise and drone. Receiving Eucharist, the very Body and Blood of Christ, can become just another stroll down the aisle on our way out the door.

But how would we live without those ordinary, everyday gifts, of sun and stars, of body and mind, of prayer and scripture and Eucharist? If they were gone, who or what would we be? Take time to pay attention and glimpse anew the grace of God that is always surrounding and enfolding us, often in ordinary, taken-for-granted ways. Christ is always present with us, whenever we gather the folks, share the stories and break the bread. Don't take for granted the miracle of that gift. Don't take for granted the deepest truth of who you are: dead to sin, living for God in Christ.

"Gracious Father, Lord of the harvest, though we are sinners, still You call us to be disciples, and You entrust a share in the mission of Jesus, who sent the Twelve to proclaim the good news and to bear witness without fear. With Your love forever sheltering and surrounding us, may we proclaim from the housetops the gospel we have heard and acknowledge openly before all the one whom we confess as Lord, Jesus the Christ, Your Son and our Brother, Who lives and reigns with You, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. Amen."

These were left in the church during Mass.

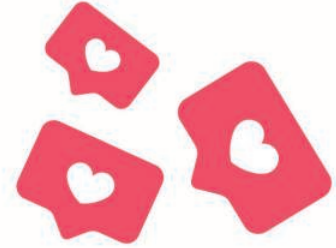
If you are missing something, please come to the parish office and look through the bin.

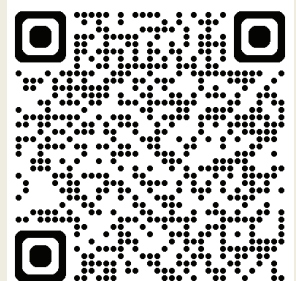
