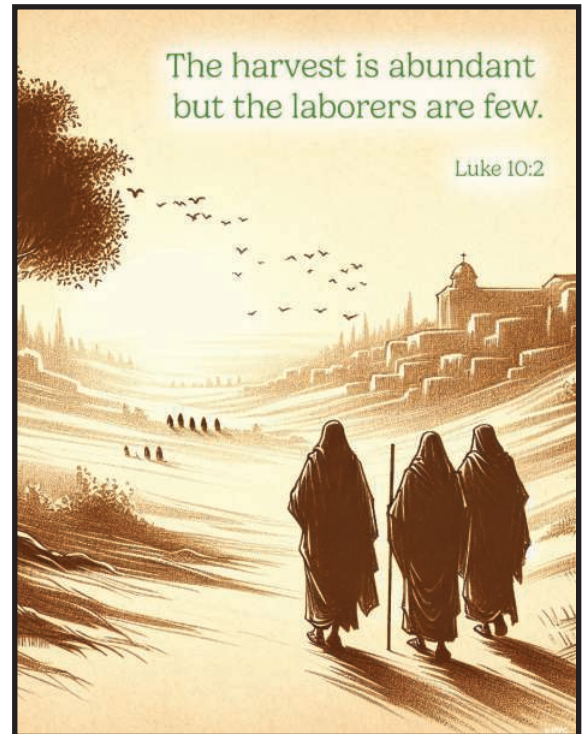

OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

Summer months, when our busy schedules tend to ease a bit, invite us to deepen our lives of prayer, by moving off the surface of our existence and plumbing the depths of our lives and of God. When you are at the beach, or tenting under the stars, consider the liminal moments of your life: a time when you lost a loved one, or felt profound loneliness, or realized that everything about human life is contingent and limited; and yet at the same time you glimpsed the More, the Mystery, Awe. Pay attention. And say Thank-You!

"For us to be here in the first place...more than a billion billion accidents took place. All our ancestors lived to puberty, coupled, and gave birth. Not just our parents, grandparents, and great-grandparents. Take it all the way back to the beginning, beyond the first Homo sapiens, back to the ur-paramesium. Even the one in a million sperm's connection with the equally unique egg is nothing compared to everything else that happened from the beginning of time until now to make it possible for us to be here.

What does this mean? Astoundingly, unbelievably, it means that we have been in utero from the beginning of creation. We can trace ourselves back, genetically, to the very beginning of time. The universe was pregnant with us when it was born.

What a luxury we enjoy, wondering what will happen after we die; even what will happen before we die. Having spent billions of years in gestation, present in all that preceded us—fully admitting the pain and difficulty involved in actually being alive, able to fail and suffer and die—we can only respond in one way: with awe and gratitude" (Forest Church, "Love and Death")

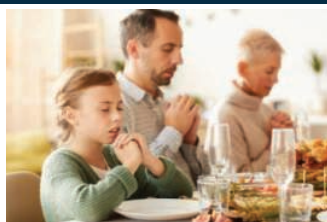
I have no greater joy than this, to hear that my children are walking in the truth. - 3 John 1:4

Raising children with a strong faith is the hope of many parents, grandparents, and other loving adults. But teaching and growth isn't simply one-sided. Adults and children have much to learn from one another on this spiritual journey. Life at home, school, and work can seem overwhelming, but setting aside time together to talk to God, to pray and to learn, helps build mighty foundations for spiritually rich lives. Every day there are simple ways to support growing Catholics in your own home. Commit to your own spiritual life. There's nothing like family life to challenge us to be our best selves. As parents, we know that children don't arrive with comprehensive instruction manuals. Some days it seems like the adventure of parenting may well be the end of us all. The good news is that God loves us with an enduring, unconditional love. As a parent, the most helpful and loving thing we can do for our children is to put on our own oxygen masks first by taking our personal spiritual growth seriously. Spend time growing in Christ yourself. Your children are watching your priorities as they make their own. This is one of the times when what is good for you is also good for them.

HOLINESS AT HOME: LIVING YOUR FAITH

Famous Meals in the Bible

Several meals in the Bible carry deep spiritual meaning and highlight the importance of gathering in faith. One of the most significant is the Last Supper, the final meal Jesus shared with His disciples before His crucifixion, during which He instituted the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Another well-known account appears in all four Gospels: the miraculous feeding of the five thousand, where Jesus multiplied five loaves and two fish to feed the crowd. At the wedding at Cana, Jesus performed His first public miracle by turning water into wine, revealing His divine nature and blessing the celebration.



These biblical meals remind us of the sacredness of sharing a table in Christ. They become moments of encounter, nourishment, and spiritual growth.

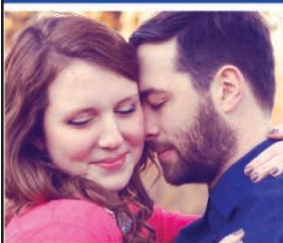
