Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

I've just completed my annual retreat, a time meant to reawaken and refocus attention on the presence of God dwelling in all events and situations. That's the same purpose for which the Lord gathers us at His table of Word and Eucharist: to awaken us to the reality of grace compenetrating every moment of our lives, and then to make concrete our responses to those gifts. Here, in this little place, we stop, we sit under the loving gaze of God, we put aside the swirl of concerns and resentments and fears, so we can listen to our breath, our heartbeat, our living in the Mystery Who Is God.

Here we die to the sin of our addictions and aggressions and fears, so that God can bring us to life in the Spirit of Christ. And filled with awe and gratitude to strengthen us, we can stand up again and continue on the pilgrimage, the journey towards our true home.

Pay extra attention to today's second reading, from Hebrews. The name Hebrew is related to the term for nomad, wanderer, journey--er. Israel's earliest name for itself, its first self-understanding was as a nation of strangers and wanderers. And the Letter to the Hebrews calls all true people of faith by the same name—wanderers, sojourners intent on seeking their true homeland.

That self-understanding should not lead Christians to despise the world's concerns and flee "this vale of tears" for other-worldly solace. After all, God's name is Emmanuel, God dwelling with us. Hebrews does not invite us to escape, but to plunge into the mystery of our human lives. Today's scriptures call us out of sentimental escapism, egoistic self-assertiveness and aggressive manipulation. Instead, the Word of God calls us to live by hope and faith and trust alone.

For faith is the confident assurance about that for which we hope. And that hope, that confidence, emerges precisely when there is no apparent justification for it. Hope is not some vague feeling that somehow everything will turn out ok. Genuine hope emerges when our only alternative is to despair, or to sleep-walk in a narcotized fog, or to exploit others to relieve our own pain.

Hope is the opposite of will-power; it is the gritty endurance by those who know that their destiny is not finally in their own hands, but in God's.

Those who hope keep expectant watch, because they know that salvation is not the equivalent to personal self-actualization and looking out for #1. Hope instead is the only possession of those who recognize that they are poor, and all they have is gift from God.

Hope belongs to those who face up to the enemies of hope—all the repressed rage, fear, desire for retribution, the self-aggrandizement at the expense of others, so well characterized by the evil servants in today's parable.

Only those who undergo the harrowing exodus of battling those enemies, in their world and in their own souls, can cross into the land of the Promise.

The temptation to avoid the journey, the seductive appeal to settle down in Egypt, to grumble and complain, to despair—that temptation is great. Yet hope is hope precisely because it continues to trust, when such trust can seem totally unreasonable. So it gives rise to faith, fidelity to the One who has made the Promise. And only in such hope and faith can one set out, like Abraham, not knowing exactly where he is going—a sure sign he is going in the right direction.

Jesus calls us to be a pilgrim people, living at the cutting edge between hope and despair; the border of the Holy; to refuse to bow down to the idols of security and facile solution and jingoism, whether political or religious; to let our treasure, and our hearts, be where we are not our own, but where we belong finally, utterly, agonizingly to God alone.




