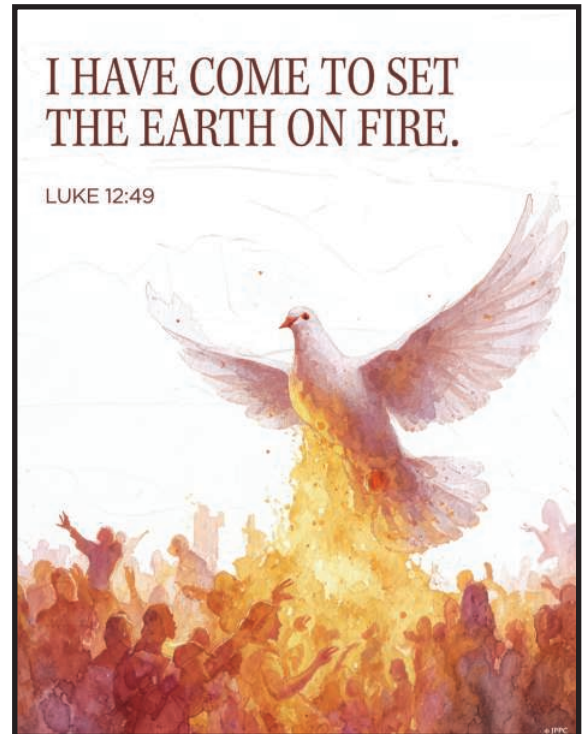

OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

The Scriptures today offer us dramatic pictures of the cost of being faithful to God and to the demands of the Reign of God. Jeremiah is thrown into a cistern, left in the cold, the mud, darkness and isolation. Hebrews describes Jesus enduring the Cross, heedless of its shame. Christ predicts that families, the very foundation of society, will be split asunder because of him.

Notice his use of apocalyptic language: we will be baptized—plunged—drowned—in the suffering he will undergo. We will be seared by the fire he will cast upon the earth.

Who can endure all that? Many of his first followers couldn't. They thrilled to his miracles, but when the talk turned to taking up the Cross, they suddenly had other places to go.

The cost of discipleship is paid in sweat and tears and blood, and long hours of hanging on, living with loneliness and insecurity and doubt.

We resist such ambiguity, so we try to tame God, to fit God into our plans and our way of running things. We try to channel the raging waters of Baptism into a few drops which we can sprinkle or dip into;

We try to reduce the purifying fire of the Holy Spirit to the smoldering wick of a Paschal Candle. We try to contain the demands of the Cross on our shoulders to a bit of jewelry hung around our neck.

But God brings us to a crossroads, where we have to decide for or against life, for or against what is good and true, beautiful and right, for or against God's Kingdom and God's Justice and God's peace, and our own best selves.

Jesus demands a definitive decision from us; discipleship precludes compromise. He spits out of his mouth the tepid. And with no middle path in which to find refuge, we each choose: we accept Jesus and his Way, and suffer the consequences; or we reject Him, and suffer the consequences. God doesn't call us to discipleship to spare us from the storm. He has made fountains of Living Water to spring up within us, and set our hearts aflame with the Spirit, and those gifts cannot be denied.

Until Jesus returns, we will be asked to pay the cost of discipleship, in fire and division, where working for peace will sometimes by the occasion of conflict; where words of love spoken in truth will sometimes lead to rejection and estrangement.

So until that great day, pray for courage, pray for wisdom, pray for the grace to be faithful. Pray that in all the moments of testing, we each will be willing to pay the cost for following Jesus the Lord.
