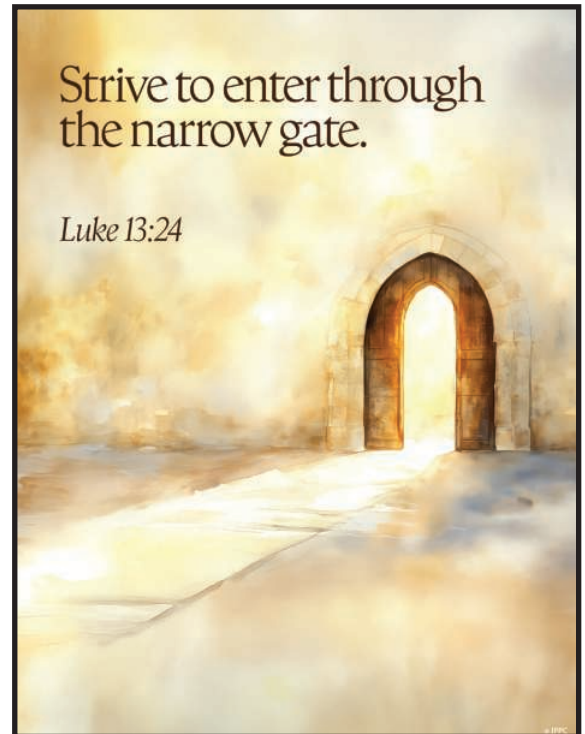

OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

"And they will come from the east and the west, from the north and the south, and will take their place at the feast in the Kingdom of God." A special welcome to any visitors who have come from afar to join us today at the Supper of the Lamb!

Jesus often pictures the Reign of God as a feast. He says the Kingdom is like the Master's great banquet, which some of the invited guests refuse to attend. Or Jesus says, God will play host to those wise ones who had invited to their table the poor, the sick, those unable to repay them. Divine forgiveness becomes tangible when the Father provides for his prodigal son the feast of a fatted calf.

Anticipating that final great Supper, Jesus is forever eating, with his disciples, with Pharisees, with sinners, so much so that people even call him a glutton and a drunkard. At the dining table Jesus gathers friends to share stories and meals together. And ever since, that's where disciples meet the risen Jesus: We gather the folks and tell the stories and break the bread. And he is with us, for it is He who breaks the Bread for us.

Remember the Emmaus story. After the crucifixion, two disciples walk on the road with the risen Lord but do not recognize Him. They tell him their hopes that Jesus was the Messiah, their crushing despair over his murder, and their confusion about the reports that he is alive again.

And Jesus listens.

Then Jesus tells them his story, "beginning with Moses and all the prophets," and he weaves together all the stories they have shared into the one great story of God's saving deliverance. But they still don't quite understand.

Finally, gathered around Jesus at table, the disciples give thanks---that's what Eucharist means--- as the Lord breaks the bread, and that's when "their eyes were opened." They finally recognized Jesus in their midst.

Our Eucharistic meal links us back to the Exodus, Passover, and God's covenant with Israel. Our meal with Jesus the Jew links us in memory and thanksgiving with that tribes of slaves set free by God's saving arm. It links us with that remnant who kept the covenant Promise alive in the face of persecution and death. The meal links us with the Chosen People into whom, in God's mercy, we have been grafted. The meal roots us in our own history.

The Eucharist continues to "open our eyes" to glimpse, not only the Lord with us but also to glimpse the holy in one another and to give thanks for the gift of one another.

And Eucharist is our anchor of hope. If Jesus dwells with us in our remembering the past and dwells with us in our giving thanks for the present, He most fully dwells as our Absolute Future, when He will fulfill and exceed our every hope and dream and expectation.

In His coming Kingdom, our longed-for reconciliation, with our own schizoid selves, with the whole tribe of humanity, with the entire cosmos itself, will be completed, and every hunger satisfied. There, finally, all our stories with their tragic twists and apparent absurdities will come out right. And we'll finally understand that all this time we have really been part of a much bigger story, the one great story, that started "in the beginning..... because God so loved the world."

At each Eucharist, the Lord gathers us so that we can look back to the sources of faith and remember, and look around to the divine dwelling in our midst, and give thanks, and look ahead to God's future, reign, and have hope. If sometimes you have trouble finding Jesus, take Luke's advice: Gather the folks, share the stories, break the bread and pass around the cup. And as you remember, and give thanks, Jesus will be in your midst.
