OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

This weekend marks the end of my second year at Greenwich, and that realization has stirred in me some reflections on what I've learned in these twenty-four months. But it didn't stop there. The exercise invited me into pondering more deeply what I've learned in my seventy-six years of life, my fifty-three years as a Jesuit religious, my forty-five years as an ordained priest, and my ten years as a parish pastor (eight at St Thomas Aquinas in Storrs prior to Greenwich).

These reflections may be, in turn, quotidian, superficial, opaque or insightful; that's for your judgment. Perhaps however they may spur your own pondering of life lessons learned as you, like Jesus, have grown "in stature and strength, filled with wisdom..." (Luke 2:40). Where have you been most alive? For that's where you have most been in God!

In the film, Rudy, the title character wants desperately to gain admittance to Notre Dame, but hasn't the aptitude to qualify, so he appeals to Fr. Cavanaugh for divine assistance. The priest replies, "Son, in thirty-five years of religious studies, I've come up with only two hard, incontrovertible facts: there is a God, and I'm not Him."

My seventy-years of human living endorse Fr. Cavanaugh's pithy comment, but I would point to many more than two realities.

I testify that all of creation is shot through with the presence of Grace, compenetrated by the Divine, inviting each person into transcendence and ecstasy, that is, ek-stasis, standing outside of ourselves and dwelling in the Mystery Who is God.

And this God comes to us, not in purely spiritual and invisible ways, but through visible, concrete, tangible, earthly things. All reality is sacramental. Everything reflects something of the beauty and life-affirming energy of God, tangible expressions of the Mystery that grounds and permeates all of life.

My abbreviated list of examples include: October foliage in New England, its beauty against the blue sky and golden sun, the pathos of those leaves falling from the maple trees, and then the evocative scent of those leaves burning; the panoply of stars and meteors stretched across the night skies of Zambia, seemingly close enough to touch; the glowworms silently illuminating the caverns at Waitomo, New Zealand, one hundred meters below the earth's surface; the delicate butterflies and the colorful lorikeets that fill the skies of Australia; the sweetness of a Maine lobster paired with a chilled Riesling; Pepe's pizza; a dozen oysters and a draft beer at Boston's Union Oyster House's raw bar; cannoli from the North End; the thrill of a kiss; the heart-breaking poignancy of losing a beloved young one.

In all these ways of touch and taste and, sight and smell and sound, God stretches open our hearts to receive ever more life and love, human and divine, that God continuously pours out upon us.

What would be on your list? What have disclosed to you the reality that you live in the presence of Mystery? What has called out awe and wonder and gratitude in you?

Next week, what I've learned from my fifty-three years as a Jesuit.
