Thanks to your generous support, offertory collections increased 7.4% over the last year. During the summer months, our offertory significantly declines and picks back up after Labor Day. Since our parish remains open all year long, consistent giving is essential for our parish to function.

Pastor's Reflection

Last week my reflection focused on some of the life lessons from my seventy-six years on earth. This time, what I've learned from my fifty-three years as a Jesuit.

Psalms 149 says, God delights in His people. I still remember a retreat at the Desert House of Prayer near Tucson when I encountered a much more liberating and affirming realization, that God delights in me, personally. And He intends to speak the same word of love and truth to each of us: God delights in you, God desires friendship and union with you, God creates you in order to share with you that intimacy with you.

On another retreat, in Australia, I experienced the Lord taking me out of the tomb, Lazarus-like, and clothing me in the robe of a child of the household of God. That crystalized my understanding of the grace of baptism, a gift bestowed on each of us who calls Jesus Lord. Again, this isn't just about me; it's an invitation to plumb the depths of our encounters with the Lord in sacrament and scripture, and consciously to accept the reality that we have been accepted, and chosen, and cradled in the arms of the God who has called us each by name.

On that same retreat, I experienced anew the liberating truth that God's grace is free gift, not a merit badge for good behavior. With God, as with any relationship of love, there are no achievements, only gifts and graces.

Praying is simply paying attention to that presence of the Holy One, delighting in us, gazing upon us with unconditional love and welcome. The invitation He extends to each of us is to grow in awareness that His loving gaze is always resting upon us. That gaze means to draw us out of ourselves and into His heart. Praying then is not just something you or I do; there is always an interplay with Another. Our prayer commences, at God's invitation, under that divine gaze. As it rests on you, let that gaze remind you that He can see what He wants to do with you during that prayer time: gentle you, perhaps, or stir you to repentance, or deepen your hunger for Him, or well up gratitude within you, or calm your fears, or sew in you the seeds of His dream for you. He can see the potentials He can bring into reality.

A simple hymn by John Bell evokes some of this: Take, o take me as I am; summon out what I shall be; set your seal upon my heart and live in me.

St. Ignatius pictures the Three Persons of the Trinity gazing upon the world, and seeing the pain and suffering sin has unleashed upon humanity; and They are drawn out of their Godself as They decide to send the Son to save the world. They repeat that same self-gift in Their gaze upon each of us personally; praying is our act of paying attention to that offer of divine self-gift. In prayer, we ask the Lord to have his gaze rest upon us, as that focuses our vision, our heart and our entire self. We will be using this hymn at mass, especially the 8:00 a.m.

Next time, what I've learned in my forty-five years of priesthood.

A prayer for back-to-school week

Master and Teacher,
