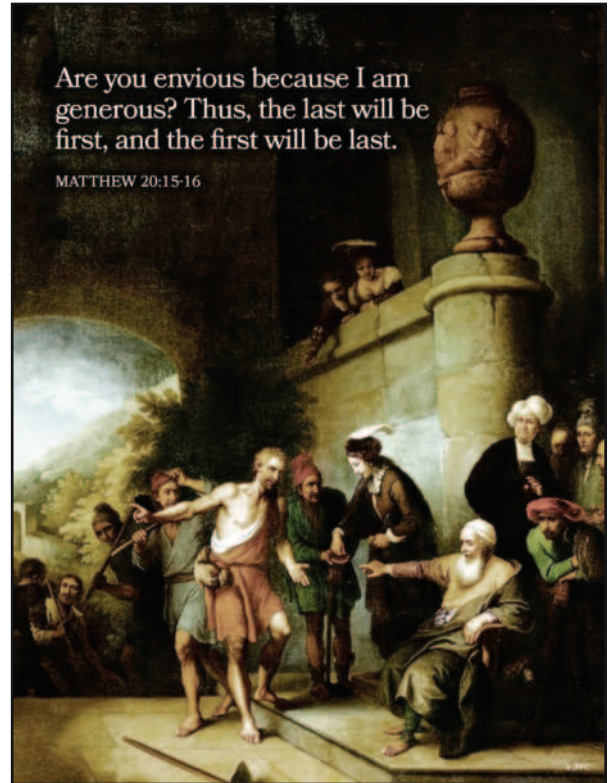

Pastor's Reflection

This weekend, we celebrate our **Ministries Fair**, an invitation to join in our liturgical ministries. I want to thank all who already serve our liturgies as readers, eucharistic ministers and altar servers, as well as the members of the Liturgy Committee. Their generosity reminds us that liturgy is "the work of the people," not just of the presiders.

Thank you to all who are helping with next weekend's parish picnic! I hope all parishioners will be able to join us immediately after the noon mass, for food, fun and friendship.

And I would like once again to thank the 228 families who participated in the 2026 Bishop's Appeal, as well as Ashley Li and Joe Barragan who chaired the Appeal.

Our parish exceeded our fundraising goal, which resulted in just over \$145,000 being returned to our parish.

This surplus, along with the proceeds from our November Gala and the Parish Golf Outing, enabled the parish to achieve an operating surplus. These additional funds allow me to fill two new, part-time, positions: a pastoral assistant who will enable us to increase our ministries, especially to teens, families with young children, and those investigating joining the Church, and business manager, to ensure that we will be prudent managers and good stewards of the finances, buildings and property entrusted to our care.

But the fact that we have to rely on those extra funds only underscores the reality that our weekly offerings still do not cover our annual budgeted expenses; and that budget is rather modest. Part of the challenge is that at any given time, a significant number of parishioners are away, either on summer vacation, or in Florida for the winter. That's why on-line giving is so helpful, and so important. But it also means that the November Gala is a crucial element of our pastoral planning.

At the same time, this generosity provides us with an opportunity to share our good fortune with another less fortunate parish. After consulting the chairs of the parish council and the finance committee, as well as the pastoral team, I have decided to give \$20,000 to St. Augustine Parish, Bridgeport, the cathedral parish. They will use the money to support their Young Adult Group, their Hispanic Men's Group and Hispanic Women's Group, and their Kids Club for children ages 5-12. In his thank-you letter to us, the pastor, Fr. Declan Creighton, wrote, "Please extend our deepest appreciation to the entire St. Michael the Archangel Parish community. Their generosity is a beautiful reflection of Christian stewardship, compassion and commitment to serving others." Amen!

I hope I will see many of you at our Gala on November 6th.
