Pastor's Reflection

This weekend the coordinators of United In Ministry are conducting our annual Ministries Fair. This is an invitation to share your own gifts of witness and service in one or more of our parish ministries as part of our one mission to proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom of God.

Liturgical Ministers:

We are in particular need of more **Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist**, so that we can receive the Eucharist under both species, the Body and Blood of Christ, at most masses. EM's also bring communion to people in Nathaniel Wetherell nursing home and to home-bound parishioners. This ministry is vital to our common life as the Body of Christ.

Another pressing need is for a dependable cadre of **ushers** to serve as **ministers of hospitality** at each mass. Ushers do more than take up the collection. They are meant to be the first to greet and welcome our guests; they are our "first responders" to circumstances like medical emergencies or disruptions to good order. Dependable ushers are crucial to our liturgical celebrations. (And they don't have to be men!!)

Lectors greet the congregation at the start of liturgy, proclaim the scriptures, and lead our prayers of petition. Serving in this ministry is a wonderful opportunity to enter more deeply into the treasures of Scripture.

Altar servers participate in the liturgies in particularly intimate ways, assisting the presiders at the altar. Boys and girls from age 8 on are invited to this ministry, as well as adults.

The talents of the **Music Ministry**, including singers and instrumentalists, add significantly to the beauty and joy of our liturgies. In addition to serving at the noon mass on Sundays, music ministers contribute to the great liturgies of Christmas and Holy Week, Confirmations and special occasions with the bishop.

Some crucial ministries in support of the liturgy take place apart from mass itself. Every week generous volunteers help with the **flowers** and the liturgical environment, wash and iron the **altar linens**, make the **white garments** for the children at their baptism, and provide **hospitality** after the 9:45 and noon masses. And we have a **Liturgy Committee** to help plan the celebrations of the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, as well as particular feasts. If one of these needs connects with some of your skills and interests, check at the tables for **Flowers, SMWA, Shawl Ministry, or Family Ministry**.

Fr. Holland and Fr. Murphy will be attending a diocesan Convocation of Priests from the evening of **Sunday October 12 until Wednesday, October 15th**, there will be no Sunday 5:15 pm mass on October 12th and no morning masses October 13-15th. St. Mary's, however, will have Sunday mass at 5:15 pm and daily mass at 12:05 pm on those days

Witness and Service:

As disciples of the Lord Jesus, we are not just "Sunday mass Catholics." And our parish offers many opportunities for encountering the Lord in daily life and growing in faith.

Our **Faith Formation** programs accompany parents and children on their faith journeys, and **catechists** assist with preparation for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. A team of three couples assist parents seeking **baptism** for their children. Our **family ministry** offers support and community involvement for parents and families. The **OCIA team** assists those seeking to join the Catholic Church or complete their sacramental preparation in adulthood. **Scripture Study** invites participants into the riches of the Bible. The **Emmaus Retreats** for women and for men offer dynamic retreat weekend retreats in the Spring that become life-changing conversion experiences. Weekly **Adoration** on Thursdays, commencing after the 9 a.m. mass and culminating in 7:00 p.m. Benediction, nurtures a depth of prayer and personal encounter with Christ.

The **Men's Ministry** offer activities to build fraternity among the men of the parish through prayer, service and social events. **SMWA** (St. Michael's Women's Association) offers spiritual and social programs to enrich the spiritual and social lives of the women of the parish. **SMWA** partners with the **Welcome Ministry** to offer hospitality and connection for new parishioners. **FIAT** (Faith in Action Together) focuses on our parish outreach and community service, including work with **Malta House** and our annual **Thanksgiving turkey drive**. The **Shawl Ministry** combines love of knitting/crocheting with compassion for those in need of comfort in times of loss or illness.

A **Young Adults ministry** is forming for young adults (20-35, married or single, all are welcome) who want to understand more about how our Catholic faith impacts the issues they face and to develop community.

And if all that is not enough, there are still more ways to be part of our family: the **parish pastoral council**, the **finance committee**, **bereavement ministry**, **spiritual direction**, our annual **September picnic**, the **Jubilee Gala on November 1st**, **Christmas tree lighting the Saturday before Christmas**, the **pasta party in February**, the **Easter Egg hunt**, the **golf outing in June**.

We are a very vibrant community, with lots of opportunities for growth in faith, witness and service. Please prayerfully consider adding your own gifts to one or more of our ministries, then stop by the tables in the narthex or contact the office.

Parish Pastoral Council Restructured

Please know that we have restructured our Parish Pastoral Council and amended the Bylaws to include the United in Ministry Committee. As always, my first priority is that we do whatever the Lord wants us to do and to become. That means my hope is that under the leadership of the newly restructured Parish Pastoral Council we all become a more discerning community, listening to the Spirit and discerning what and where the Lord wants us to be. To that end, as of the June 2025 Council meeting, we have restructured the Council... reducing the size of the Council with the intent of it becoming a more strategic, visioning and discerning body which will meet more often and work with the United in Ministry Committee. The United in Ministry Committee is comprised of the leaders/co-leaders of all our ministries and is missioned to "promote and ensure open communication, collaboration and cohesiveness across parish ministry strategies and events."

In addition, the United in Ministry (UIM) Committee now has a specific place in the Bylaws thus giving the UIM a foundational role in parish governance. The Parish Council takes seriously not only individual ministries, but expressly as effective collaborators in the one mission of the parish, to proclaim the good news.

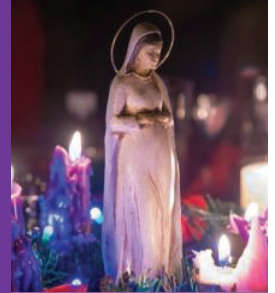

FAITH FORMATION

A lifelong journey, childhood-teens-adults

Monday September 29th is the feast of the Archangels Gabriel, Raphael and our own Michael.

The day's gospel says, "You will see the sky open and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man." (John 1:51)

Angels - messengers from God - appear frequently in Scripture, but only Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are named.

Michael appears in Daniel's vision as "the great prince" who defends Israel against its enemies; in the *Book of Revelation*, he leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil. Devotion to Michael is the oldest angelic devotion, rising in the East in the fourth century. The Church in the West began to observe a feast honoring Michael and the angels in the fifth century.

Gabriel also makes an appearance in Daniel's visions, announcing Michael's role in God's plan. His best-known appearance is an encounter with Mary, who consents to bear the Messiah.

Raphael's activity is confined to the Old Testament story of Tobit. There he appears to guide Tobit's son Tobiah through a series of fantastic adventures which lead to a threefold happy ending: Tobiah's marriage to Sarah, the healing of Tobit's blindness, and the restoration of the family fortune."

The people of God in every age have intuited the presence of angelic messengers and ministering spirits, surrounding them, protecting them, leading them forward: angels sing for joy at the act of Creation; they visit Abraham and Sarah; rescue Lot, wrestle with Jacob, pass over those marked with the lamb's blood at the Exodus, accompany Israel's armies into battle. Angels minister to Jesus in the wilderness, stand at the tomb of Jesus to console and challenge the women, rescue Peter from prison, accompany Philip, call Cornelius to conversion, console Paul when his ship is in danger.

Angels are concrete expressions of God's constant providential care for us. Sometimes we even pay attention and notice. As scripture says, "Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing so, some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it." For in that way, sometimes we have ourselves been angels, messengers, ministering spirits, to one another.

For the angels in our lives, mostly anonymous, we give thanks on this feast of Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, archangels. Amen.



As our Faith Formation sessions begin, let's take this time to recognize our wonderful volunteers who are bringing the teachings of our Catholic faith to our children and to some adults. Please thank your child's Faith Formation teacher for giving his/her time to this great ministry. When speaking to catechists, Pope Francis said, "*Catechists are called to make visible and tangible the person of Jesus Christ who loves each one of you.*"
