Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Given this winter's blustery conditions and our parishioners' typical travel plans, we have experienced a significant drop-off in offertory receipts over the last two months. Through the end of February offertory receipts are up just over 3% from last year when our budget required a closer to 7% increase. I once again ask each parish family to contribute \$40 in weekly offertory, \$2,000 per year, to ensure the long-term financial health of our parish. Please prayerfully consider making this commitment to our parish.

Pastor's Reflection

"He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." (Nicene Creed)

"Only one Evangelist, Luke, talks about the Ascension as a separate dimension of the life of Christ. Only Luke, in Acts, dates it "on the fortieth day." That the resurrection proved Jesus' identity with God the other evangelists took for granted. They link the Ascension to Easter itself. But Luke has another lesson in mind. Jewish students studied with a rabbi "forty days," a symbolic number meaning the amount of time it took them to learn the master's teachings well enough to be able to repeat them. To Luke, then, the time after we experience the Resurrection may have less to do with Jesus than it does with us, with the centering of our minds and hearts on the world and the work at hand. To acknowledge the Resurrection, to be raised to a new understanding of Jesus ourselves, in other words, requires the fashioning of a life of contemplative awareness.

Jesus came to be among us, the Creed sings. Jesus walked the earth and blessed it. Jesus lived the life of the living and grew in "wisdom, age, and grace" here. But Jesus raised our eyes above and beyond the narrow limits of our paltry little lives, showed us other horizons, gives us a world beyond ourselves. In the end, out of the dregs of the worst the world has to offer, the Creed lifts our eyes and our souls to the vision that transcends the pedestrian. The Creed brings us face to face with the mystical and reminds us to abide there all the while we walk the streets of the world." (Joan Chittister)

Silent Homilies

In families where religion is transmitted successfully, sacred objects are powerful. Statues of saints and the Blessed Mother, candles near photos of deceased members of the family, crucifixes on the wall, pictures of Jesus knocking at the door – all these can serve as silent homilies for children.

“Silent Homilies” help us feel the Holy Spirit and stay close to God at home. When we place special holy things around our house - like a cross, a statue of Mary or a saint, blessed palms, sacred art, the use of candles during prayer, or even a small font of holy water, they quietly remind us that the Holy Spirit is with us. These peaceful signs help us think about Jesus, listen to God's gentle voice, and remember to pray and love like He does. They don't use words but fill our hearts and home with the light, peace, and love of the Holy Spirit, making our house a holy place where God's presence is always near.

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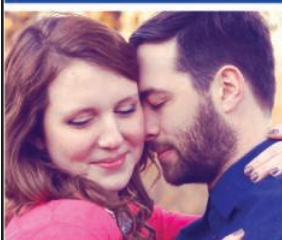
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
