OFFERTORY

Be good Stewards of our Parish home ...

Thanks to your generous support, parish offertory receipts have increased 5% over last year through the end of April. With Memorial Day and the start of summer, however, our offertory typically experiences a significant decline from now until after Labor Day.

Though schools close for the next three months, our parish remains open all year long, and consistent offertory giving is essential for parish growth. Many parishioners travel throughout the summer, so we ask those who will be away from Greenwich to support our parish even on those weekends when you are attending mass elsewhere. It's very helpful if you use the on-line giving option and link it to a regular weekly or monthly gift, and if you are willing to check the box for absorbing the transaction cost, that helps even more!

The Finance Committee's upcoming report to the parish will show that while the weekly collections are up, they still struggle to cover the parish operating costs. Consequently, I renew my request to each parish family to increase their weekly contribution to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael's. Please prayerfully consider your financial commitment to our parish.

HOLINESS AT HOME: LIVING YOUR FAITH

Sacred Steps

“As I have loved you, so you also should love one another.” — John 13:34

Teaching children to serve others in love is essential to nurturing their faith. Through acts of kindness and service, they grow in empathy, live out Jesus' teachings, and build a lasting commitment to compassionate, faith-filled living.

Taken from the Sacred Steps resource of the First Witnesses initiative, here are some concrete suggestions for raising your children to serve the needs of others as part of teaching how love is a part of their faith, drawn from various age ranges.



Birth to 6 Months

- Invite godparents and parish members into your child's life, fostering a community of faith and support.
- Create a peaceful, nurturing home environment to model Christian love and care from the earliest moments.

6 to 24 Months

- Encourage children to share, be fair, and be honest with friends and playmates.
- Teach respect for nature as part of God's creation, instilling early stewardship values.
- Engage extended family members to demonstrate communal care and connectedness.

3 to 6 Years

- Involve children in simple acts of service such as helping set the table, choosing toys to donate, or participating in seasonal giving projects.
- Talk about helping others as a way of loving Jesus and living the Gospel.
- Celebrate acts of kindness and service within the family to reinforce the value of giving.

6 to 9 Years

- Read and discuss Gospel stories that highlight service, such as the Good Samaritan or the Washing of the Disciples' Feet.
- Encourage participation in parish outreach or family-led service activities (like food drives or visiting elderly neighbors)
- Help children reflect on their actions and how they can positively impact others in their community.

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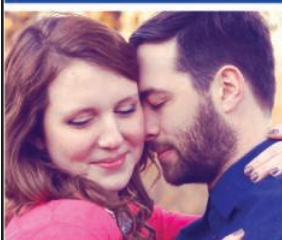
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
