The Finance Committee's upcoming report, due out in October, will show that while the weekly collections were up, they still did not fully cover our parish's operating costs.

Consequently, I strongly encourage each parishioner or family to increase their weekly offertory to \$40 to help ensure the long-term financial health of St. Michael.

Pastor's Reflection

Halloween, All Saints and All Souls 2025

History usually is the story of conquerors, where greatness is measured in heroes, military victories and conquered populations. Alexander the Great was called that because he had killed more people than anyone else in history.

The Church however remembers a different kind of hero. We remember the saints, who suffered unjustly, or who alleviated the suffering of others. We say that Saints in fact are center-stage of the history that really matters.

Saints resemble the One we worship as Savior and Lord, who himself lived in a backwater region, belonged to a ridiculed and despised race, died condemned as a criminal and blasphemer, abandoned seemingly even by God. Yet we claim Him as the center and Lord of the cosmos, the one by whom we measure all time and all history.

The Feast of All Saints teaches us to look beyond appearances and glimpse, in their earthly lives and deaths, the first fruits of the abundant harvest of God's Kingdom. All Saints reminds us that Halloween, the night of the Lord of Death, has yielded to the Sun of Justice. God's goodness, and not the Evil One, triumphs. Christ, the Lord of Life, has conquered death.

And the Feast trumpets our own call to holiness. We remember, on All Souls Day, all our beloved dead, sinners like us, beloved like us, mortal like us. And, like them, God calls us out of darkness into His own wondrous light. And out of this Church of beloved sinners God is fashioning the heavenly court of the saints. For we are not holy on our own; it is God who makes us holy, sets us apart and consecrates us.

These Feast days stir in us a renewed sense of reverence for ourselves and for one another. Look around and see people for whom Jesus shed His Blood. Look around and see people whom Jesus calls to be his followers and disciples. Look around and see people entrusted with His Word and His Sacrament and His life. Look around and see people Jesus is making holy as he is holy, people whom He is calling to be Saints.

And please inscribe in our Book of the Deceased the names of your own beloved dead. The Book will remain in the sanctuary throughout the month of November and we will commend to the Lord all those inscribed there.

Next week we return to our reflections on Eucharist.

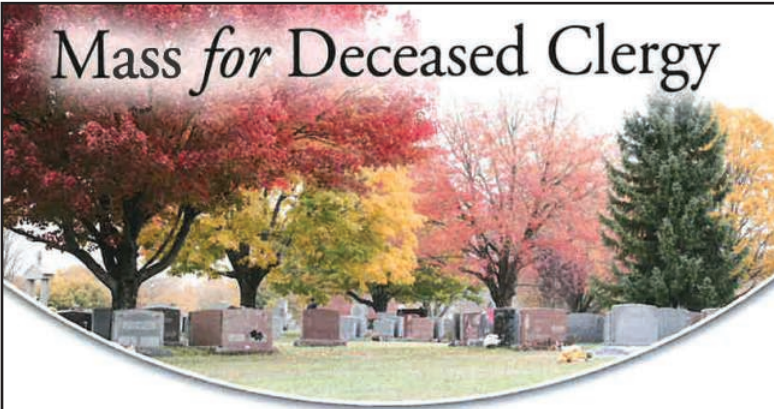

FAITH FORMATION

A lifelong journey, childhood-teens-adults

In the Catholic Church, November is a time of remembrance for those who have died and a time to pray for the souls in purgatory:

- **Remembering the dead**

The Catholic Church remembers those who have died and looks forward to joining them in heaven. This is a time to give thanks to those who have gone before us.

- **Praying for the souls in purgatory**

The Church prays for those who are in purgatory and need purification from sin and selfishness. It is believed that the souls in purgatory will eventually enter heaven and become powerful intercessors on behalf of those who pray for them.

- **All Saints Day**

November 1st, a day to remember all saints and martyrs during Christian history.

- **All Souls Day**

On November 2nd, the Church celebrates the Feast of All Souls and encourages the faithful to honor the graves of their deceased and have Masses said for them.

Fr. Rob Galea recently reminded a group of students of something we had either forgotten or perhaps never heard. Psalm 40:11.

We can recite it by heart: “Be still, and know that I am God.”

When we read it, we probably think of being quiet before God, contemplating the many gifts and wonders He has given. We think of the beach or serene landscapes. We think of rest, letting go. We think of peace.

But that is not what the passage means.

The passage is about war. It starts with the great promise that God is the refuge of His people, where they can find protection from that which endangers them. Read just before this passage, and you will see the nations raging against God before moving to God’s responses of bringing destruction upon the earth and the nations.

The setting is a battlefield. In this war, God protects His people and brings the nations into submission. In this psalm, God enters the fray of the raging nations and tells them to pipe down. Like a parent stopping an argument among the children, he raises His voice (or doesn’t) and speaks.

Shut up. Be quiet. Please stop it. And let me be God.

That is the literal translation. That is the instruction. It’s not “sit quietly and reflect on the peaceful sunset.”

No, it is, “Shut your mouth. I am in charge.”

God rules. God conquers. God enters the battlefield and stops the fighting.

We could do with a little more of that these days.

Silent Homilies

A **rosary display** can encourage prayer while inviting us to meditate on Christ’s life, death, and resurrection, where forgiveness and grace are most fully revealed. By keeping the rosary visible and accessible, families create a gentle call to seek God’s strength, mercy, and healing each day. In this way, the Rosary is a silent homily that helps form hearts that are humble, repentant, and open to God’s love.



People should present their requests to God with prayer, petition, and thanksgiving, and God's peace will guard their hearts and minds.

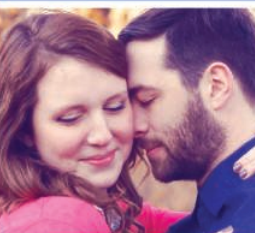
