The following pages consist of our General Price List and Casket Price List, in compliance with the Federal Trade Commission's "Funeral Rule" for your information and benefit. Included within these price lists are several disclosures that are required by either Federal or State Law. At the time you receive this packet your director will tell you about all of these disclosures and request that you sign and date forms that indicate that you received them, both verbally and in print.

"Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements, is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in part or in full, by or on behalf of the decedent." Note: Authority cited – Section 7606, Business and Professions Code. Reference: Sections 7606, 7685 and 7745, Business and Professions Code.

NOTICE REGARDING CREMATED REMAINS: A person having the right to control disposition of cremated remains may remove the remains in a durable container from the place of cremation, pursuant to Section 7054.6 of the Health and Safety Code.

If the cremated remains container cannot accommodate all cremated remains of the decedent, the crematory shall provide a larger cremated remains container at no additional cost or place the excess in a second container that cannot easily come apart from the first, pursuant to Section 8345 of the Health and Safety Code.

Full payment must be made at least 24 hours before any merchandise, ceremonies, or disposition are provided. Acceptable forms of payment include cash, cashier's check, ACH, Visa, MasterCard and Assignable/Incontestable life insurance policies. There will be a 10% processing fee on all life insurance policies added to the Statement of Funeral Goods and Services selected. We do not accept estate claims.

All information given to the counselor at the time funeral arrangements are made must be correct vital information prior to filing with the State of California. It is the responsibility of the Contracting Party to provide the counselor with the correct information. If the information given is incorrect after the filing process has been completed, the death certificate must be amended. This can take several weeks and you will be responsible for all additional charges to amend the death certificate.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and Overhead

Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangements conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary certificates and permits; shelter of remains for the first 3 days.

Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utilities, secretarial and administrative costs and equipment and inventory expenses.

Our basic services and overhead fee will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations and immediate burials.)

Embalming	\$ 495
Except in certain special circumstances, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Direct Cremation

Includes the basic services of the funeral director, staff and overhead; transferring the Remains to the funeral home; securing and filing necessary certificates and permits; refrigeration; delivery of remains to crematory and return of cremated remains to funeral home. Cremated remains must be released in a durable container. A temporary plastic container is included. Cremation fees and DCA fee is included. A selection of Urns is available for you to choose from.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. These containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). We offer a fiberboard (cardboard) container with no lining or outer covering. A cremation casket is also available. You may provide your own container as long as it meets the state and crematory requirements.

Additional cremation fees apply for weights over 250 pounds	\$ 2 per pound
If you wish to have an expedited cremation, it can be done within 24 hours if receipt of the CA Disposition permit.	\$ 450

Traditional Funeral Service
