'**Hokum and Hooch**' are otherwise known as Rikki Hansel & Rebecca Hallworth.

The duo joined forces in 2021 and travel and perform regularly in the UK and overseas. They can often be spotted with their much beloved Dog, Yogi in their unique and beautifully crafted roaming home 'Herbie'- an old , converted, wooden slatted Horsebox (completed late 2024).

Rikki and Rebecca started performing together when they instantly clicked with a shared love of travel and music styles of the 50's 60's 70's.

In 2025 the pair decided to dedicate their full time and energies into writing, performing and travelling and have been successfully featured at a number of UK festivals such as Vanlife, VanLove and ABR as well as at events and music venues in Europe and South East Asia.

The duo were invited to perform at The Badlands Weekender & Mojacar Music Mile Festival in Spain during October 2025 - and completed a 2000 mile convoy with Herbie The HorseBox (All in just 30 days!)

The sound of Hokum and Hooch is often described by audiences as capturing the spirit of The Summer of Love with a strong influence of 50's, 60's & 70's blues and folk psychedelia . Close and Seamless harmonies mixed with flute and harmonica solo's are also a distinctive feature. Instruments include; Guitar, bass, ukulele, harmonica, flute, percussion, keys.

The Musical HorseBox hosted by Hokum and Hooch is a music installation with the duo performing a variety of sets and shows throughout events.

Hokum and Hooch are excited to announce the release of their first EP.



The bluesy Duo will take you back to where the roots of the blues all began, taking you on a journey and sharing music from 1920s through to the 1950s. Capturing the sounds of the American blues scene from the deep south to Chicago. Expect to hear music from artists such as Bessie Smith, Ma Rainey, Robert Johnson, Leadbelly, Elmore James, Howlin Wolf, Little Walter and Muddy Waters who soulfully and through tough times paved the way of the blues and rock music of the 60s through to today.

Celebrating 4 decades of the American Blues scene, the History of The Blues will take you back to the roots of culture and music in a world that no longer exists.


Canada to California

Expect to hear the music of artists such as Neil Young, Joni Mitchell, Jefferson Airplane, The Mamas & The Papas, Canned Heat, Crosby Stills, Nash & Young and The Byrds who were all leading the way in the folk rock and psychedelic scene.
