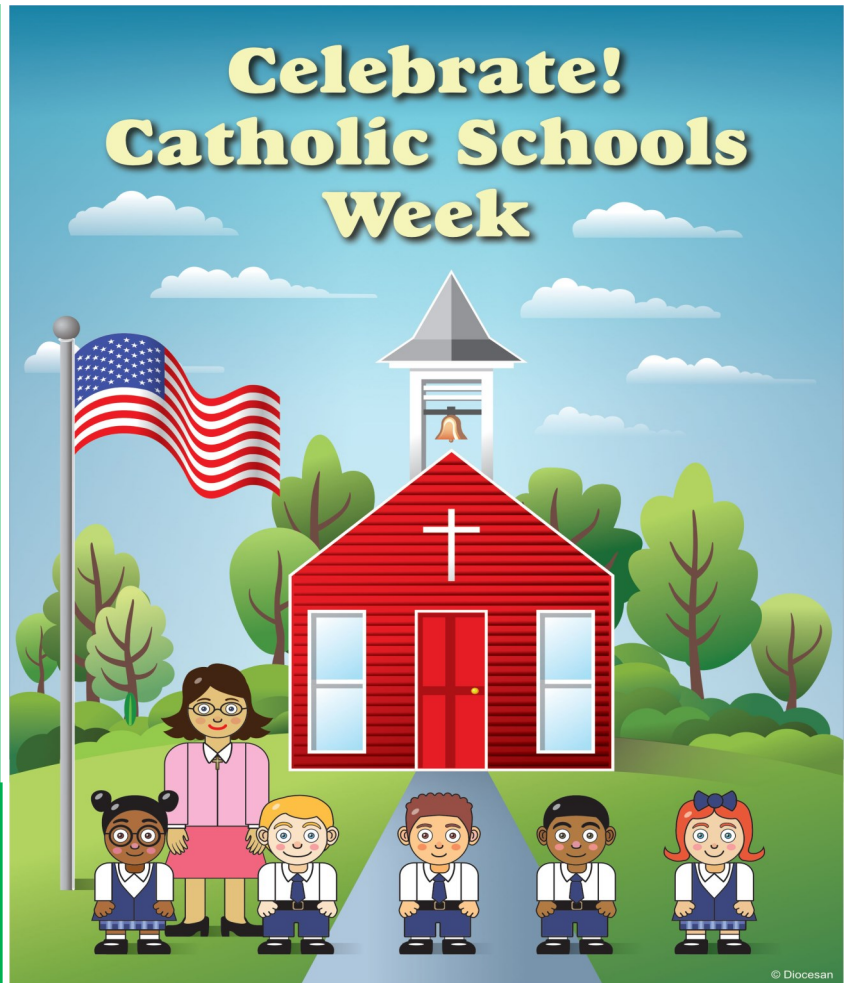

“Sunday of the Word of God & National Catholic Schools Week”

This week, our parish joins the universal Church in celebrating “Sunday of the Word of God”, a day Pope Francis established to renew our love for Sacred Scripture. At the same time, we begin “National Catholic Schools Week”, a joyful reminder of the gift and mission of Catholic education in forming hearts, minds, and souls.

These two celebrations beautifully complement each other. The Word of God is not simply a text to be studied—it is “a living voice”, speaking hope, direction, and identity into our lives. Catholic education, whether in our schools, religious education programs, or homes, exists to help our young people hear that voice clearly and confidently.

“The Word That Forms Us”

Scripture tells us, “Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light for my path.” When we allow God’s Word to shape our decisions, our relationships, and our priorities, we discover a path that leads to peace and purpose. Today is an invitation to open our Bibles with fresh eyes, to listen attentively at Mass, and to let the Gospel take root in our daily lives.

The Mission of Catholic Education: National Catholic Schools Week reminds us that Catholic education is more than academics—it is a ministry of the Church. It forms disciples who think critically, act compassionately, and live faithfully. We honor our teachers, staff, catechists, volunteers, and families who sacrifice, serve, and witness to the faith with such dedication.

Whether our children attend Catholic school or participate in parish religious formation, we share one mission: “to help them encounter Christ and build a future grounded in truth, virtue, and hope”.
