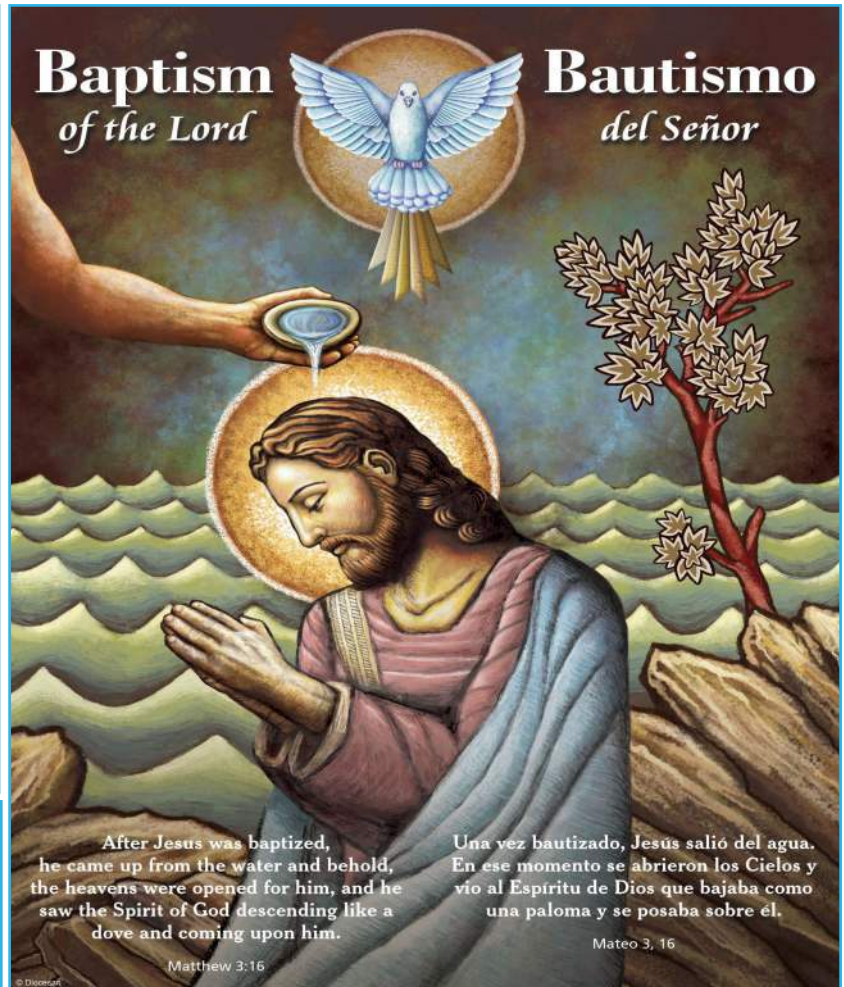

The Baptism of the Lord

As we celebrate the “Baptism of the Lord”, we stand at the threshold between Christmas joy and the beginning of Jesus’ public ministry. Today’s feast reminds us that the hidden years of Nazareth now open into a mission that will reveal the Father’s mercy to the world.

In the waters of the Jordan, Jesus—who is without sin—steps into line with sinners. He chooses solidarity over distance, compassion over judgment, accompaniment over isolation. When He rises from the water, the heavens open, the Spirit descends like a dove, and the Father proclaims: “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” This moment is not only a revelation of who Jesus is; it is a revelation of who “we” are in Him.

Through our own baptism:

- We are claimed as beloved sons and daughters of God
- We receive the Holy Spirit who strengthens, guides, and renews us
- We are called to continue Christ’s mission of mercy, justice, and healing
- We become part of a family—the Church—where no one walks alone

Today is a beautiful invitation to “remember our baptismal identity”. The world often tries to define us by our failures, our past, our limitations, or our fears. But God defines us by His love. Baptism is not a memory; it is a living grace that shapes every day of our discipleship.

As we begin Ordinary Time, may we allow the Spirit to stir in us the same courage that filled Jesus at the Jordan. Let us renew our commitment to prayer, to service, to compassion, and to building a parish community where every person knows they are loved by God.

May the Sacred Heart of Jesus strengthen us to live as His beloved children, and may the Holy Spirit guide our parish in unity, holiness, and joyful mission.

El Bautismo del Señor

Al celebrar el Bautismo del Señor, nos encontramos en el umbral entre la alegría de la Navidad y el comienzo del ministerio público de Jesús. La fiesta de hoy nos recuerda que los años de vida oculta en Nazaret dan paso ahora a una misión que revelará la misericordia del Padre al mundo.

En las aguas del Jordán, Jesús, que no tiene pecado, se une a la fila de los pecadores. Elige la solidaridad en lugar de la distancia, la compasión en lugar del juicio, el acompañamiento en lugar del aislamiento. Cuando sale del agua, los cielos se abren, el Espíritu desciende como una paloma y el Padre proclama: «Tú eres mi Hijo amado; en ti me complazco». Este momento no es solo una revelación de quién es Jesús, sino también una revelación de quiénes somos “nosotros” en Él.

A través de nuestro propio bautismo:

- Somos reconocidos como hijos e hijas amados de Dios.
- Recibimos el Espíritu Santo que nos fortalece, nos guía y nos renueva.
- Somos llamados a continuar la misión de Cristo de misericordia, justicia y sanación.
- Nos convertimos en parte de una familia, la Iglesia, donde nadie camina solo.

Hoy es una hermosa invitación a «recordar nuestra identidad bautismal». El mundo a menudo intenta definarnos por nuestros fracasos, nuestro pasado, nuestras limitaciones o nuestros miedos. Pero Dios nos define por su amor. El bautismo no es un simple recuerdo; es una gracia viva que moldea cada día de nuestro discipulado.

Al comenzar el Tiempo Ordinario, permitamos que el Espíritu despierte en nosotros el mismo valor que llenó a Jesús en el Jordán. Renovemos nuestro compromiso con la oración, el servicio, la compasión y la construcción de una comunidad parroquial donde cada persona sepa que es amada por Dios.

Que el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús nos fortalezca para vivir como sus hijos amados, y que el Espíritu Santo guíe a nuestra parroquia en unidad, santidad y una misión gozosa.
