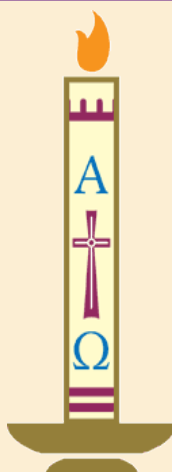

Easter Sunday

Alleluia! The exclamation rings out across the land, and we who are disciples of Jesus Christ pause to reflect on the reality that He rose from the grave and, in turn, conquered death. In today's colleges and universities, in pulpits of every denomination, and in books and journals, there are those who say it is unimportant whether or not He really rose from the dead. They say that the facts do not impact the moral of the story.

Of course, two thousand years of Christianity give evidence that they are incorrect. What the faithful of many generations have experienced and given testimony to is not something built on an idea. It is not a philosophy or a self-help psychology. The church is a direct result of real events in the course of human history.

Without those real events, we simply follow a man who showed us a different way to live. Instead, we follow a God who emptied himself into a human form, suffered the pain of torture and death at the hands of those he had created, and then shattered the chains of death so that we in our human form may follow suit.

Today, humanity is redeemed. It is time to face the facts!

THE HOPE OF RENEWAL



While it was still dark on that first Easter morning, Mary Magdalene bravely made her way to the tomb in which the body of Jesus was placed after His Death on the Cross. She went to complete the rites of anointing for the dead, which because of the Sabbath restrictions, were not done on Friday. She found the tomb empty and despaired that someone had removed the body of Jesus. Then, beyond all expectation, she heard her name, "Mary," and recognized Jesus, alive, risen from the dead.

An ancient Easter Sequence, a hymn sung before the Gospel on Solemnities, "Victimae Paschali Laudes," addresses Mary about that experience. "Tell us Mary, what did you see?" To which she responds, "Christ, my HOPE, is risen." Mary experiences hope from her encounter with the Risen Lord. "Christ, my HOPE is risen." May this Easter Sunday and the Fifty Days of this Easter Season renew in you that same hope that Mary Magdalene experienced on the first Easter.

God did not abandon Jesus in death, nor does God abandon you. Sin and death are defeated on the Cross of Christ.

Through Baptism, you share in that Easter victory. You can

know hope despite experiencing the effects of both sin and death. What Easter did for Mary Magdalene, it can do for you – touch you with hope, which bears to you the face of Jesus. It is not abstract. It is an encounter with the Risen Lord born of faith.

Václav Havel, a playwright and former president of the Czech Republic, wrote about hope: it "is not the conviction that something will turn out well, but the certainty that something makes sense no matter how it turns out."

Meaninglessness is not the last word for those to whom the Resurrection of Jesus at Easter brings hope. The "Catechism of the Catholic Church" teaches, "Hope keeps us from discouragement; sustains us during time of abandonment; preserves us from selfishness, and leads to happiness."

The sorrows, cruelties and difficulties of everyday life can lay heavily on our hearts, minds and souls. Easter is God's new creation, and it has the potential to recreate us. It is God's work in Jesus and by faith in us.

Emily Dickinson in her poem, "Hope Is the Thing With Feathers," wrote that like a bird, hope flies in and "perches in the soul." May hope perch in your soul as you celebrate

Easter Sunday and throughout the Easter Season.

May HOPE nest in your life so that you, too, can confess with Easter faith, "Christ, my Hope is Risen." ©LPi

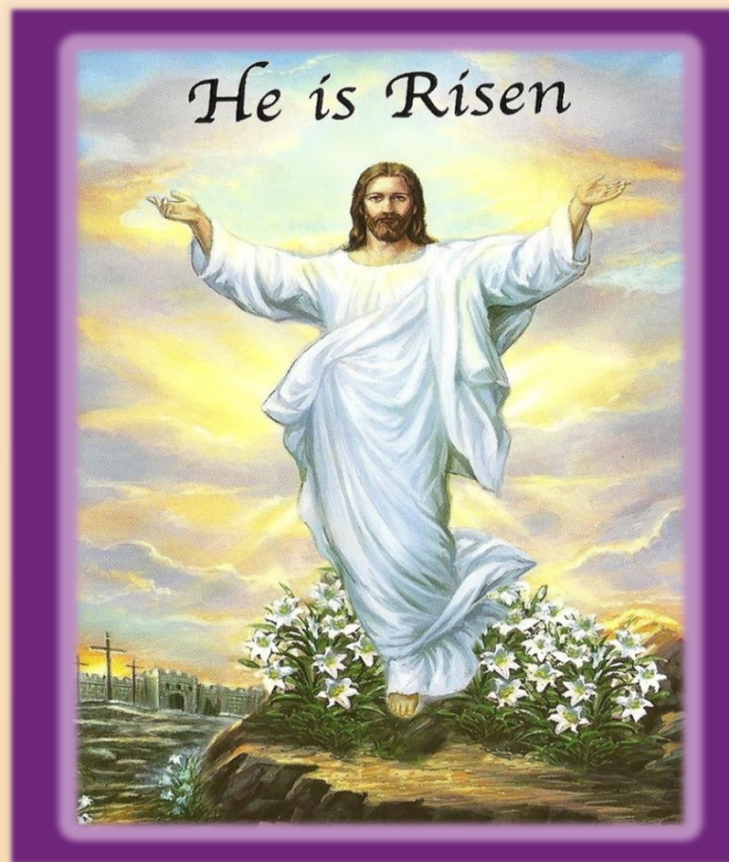

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, [reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline \(ChildLine\) at 1-800-932-0313](#) or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. The Importance of Easter Lilies

It is Easter and our church is filled with many beautiful and fragrant flowers, chief among them the lily. The magnificent white lily known as the Easter Lily has long stood as a symbol of purity, hope, innocence and peace. Also called the Bermuda lily, the Trumpet lily, and Jacob's Tears, the Easter lily is a biblical flower commonly associated with the resurrection of Christ.

In Christian tradition, the Easter lily signifies rebirth and a new beginning. It is said that beautiful white lilies sprang up in the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus wept in the last hours before he was betrayed by Judas. Another legend claims that the white lilies grew from the repentant tears shed by Eve upon her departure from Paradise.

The lily is mentioned frequently throughout the bible and serves today as a beautiful reminder of the significance of the Easter season. Easter lilies grace homes and churches each spring as a symbol of purity, joy, hope and life.
