All who are seriously sick, hospitalized, or having surgery can receive this sacrament. Please call the rectory if you wish to be anointed.


Sponsor Cards

Holy and beloved saint, teach me to believe, as you did, that in the Blessed Eucharist I will find Jesus, who has only to say the word that I may be healed.


Great servant of Christ, remember the needs of my family and all those I pray for.

For six months, people throughout our diocese responded to Pope Francis' call to the Synod on Synodality by sharing their hopes, concerns and dreams for the Catholic Church. Some participated at listening sessions, and many others through an online survey. Through this participation, many themes began to emerge. How Does it Work?



Late in her life, she fell too ill to attend church, and one day the images and sounds of the entire


This story would have been well-known to Italian native Pope Pius XII, who in 1957 named
