For the past couple of months, we have been busy planning music and events and are now looking forward to a great Fall semester! This month would be a great time to consider participating in the music program of our church. There are many ways in which you can be involved! Please take a few minutes to read about each of our different music ministries. Please contact us you are interested in joining any of groups or would like more information. If you are not available to actively participate in any of these groups, then please consider picking one to cover with your prayers! This is just one of many ways you can "love your church" as well as show the love of Jesus and proclaim the Good News of His salvation.

<u>Children's Music:</u> Children's choirs meet as part of Wednesday Methodist Bunch. Please note that K-5 age groups will meet at the same time this semester. The K-5 Children's Choir meets from 4:45-5:30. The Preschool Choir meets from 5:30-5:45. Here are some dates that we are planning to have the children's choirs involved in worship this Fall:


