## ABOUT THE ADRC OF ST. CROIX COUNTY

The Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) of St. Croix County, located in New Richmond, Wisconsin, serves as a central access point for information, assistance, and support related to aging and disability. As a trusted and welcoming resource, the ADRC supports older adults, adults with physical or intellectual disabilities, caregivers, and families.

As one of the fastest-growing counties in Wisconsin, St. Croix County is committed to remaining a vibrant community for older adults. The ADRC plays a vital role in this effort by providing essential services, including Information and Assistance, Options Counseling, Disability and Elder Benefit Services, Dementia Care programming, Caregiver Support, Nutrition programming—including home-delivered meals—healthy aging programs, and transportation services. These coordinated services help individuals maintain independence, dignity, and quality of life.

### MISSION AND VISION

The mission of the ADRC of St. Croix County is to provide older adults and people with disabilities access to the resources and supports needed to live with dignity, security, and maximum independence. The ADRC empowers individuals to make informed choices while streamlining access to appropriate services and supports.

The ADRC's vision is to serve as a visible, accessible, and widely recognized first point of contact for aging and disability resources, promoting easy access to innovative and responsive services.

### WHAT WE DO

The ADRC provides personalized information, assistance, and referrals to help individuals navigate aging- and disability-related services. Staff work collaboratively with individuals and families to explore options, identify needs, and connect them with appropriate community resources and support.

### WHO WE SERVE

The ADRC serves older adults and individuals with physical or intellectual disabilities, as well as their caregivers and families, by connecting them to services that support independence and quality of life.

# ADRC SERVICES

## Information & Assistance/Options Counselors

ADRC Specialists serve individuals 17 years and 6 months of age and older. They offer free, confidential guidance to older adults, people with physical or intellectual disabilities, and those assisting them—including families, friends, and caregivers.

## Disability Benefit Specialists

Disability Benefit Specialists (DBS) assist individuals aged 17 years 6 months to 59 with obtaining and maintaining public benefits, as well as helping with Social Security Disability applications and appeals.

## Elder Benefit Specialists

Elder Benefit Specialists (EBS) provide information about Medicare, Medicaid, supplemental insurance and all other public benefits, as well as aiding with grievances and appeals when necessary.

## Dementia Care Specialists

The Dementia Care Specialist (DCS) provides support and information for individuals concerned about memory

loss, those living with dementia, caregivers, and the broader community.

## Nutrition Services

The ADRC Senior Nutrition Program provides hot, nutritionally balanced meals for individuals aged 60 and older and their spouses, regardless of age.

Each site also serves as a hub for social engagement, educational activities, and community connection through partnerships with the local Senior Centers.

## Home-Delivered Meals

This program provides hot, nutritious meals to individuals aged 60 and over who are unable to prepare meals on their own, as well as to their caregivers or spouses. Adults under 60 with disabilities may also participate on a full-cost basis.

## Transportation

The transportation program provides transportation to persons 60 & older and to persons with disabilities. The Transportation service is available in the communities of: Baldwin, Deer Park, Glenwood City, Hammond, Hudson, New Richmond, Roberts, Somerset and Woodville and provides transportation to local Senior Centers/Nutrition Sites, medical appointments, employment, shopping and social destinations.

## Caregiver Support

Through the National Family Caregiver and Alzheimer's Family Caregiver Support Programs, the ADRC offers a range of services to assist caregivers in their vital roles—with support and guidance available from a dedicated Caregiver Support Coordinator.

## Adult Day Respite – DayAway Program

DayAway is a structured, social program for older adults and individuals with cognitive challenges such as dementia. Activities are engaging and varied, with a light snack included.

## Healthy Aging Programs

ADRC offers interactive, evidence-based classes to improve health, independence, and quality of life. Topics include self-care, medication management, communication with healthcare providers, and more.

## Outreach and Public Education

The ADRC distributes a monthly newsletter to increase awareness of services, events, and resources available to older adults and people with disabilities in St. Croix County.

## ABUSE AND NEGLECT

### Elder Abuse & Neglect

Involves a person aged 60 or older who is subjected to physical or emotional abuse, financial exploitation, and neglect or self-neglect. Abusers are often relatives of the victim, although friends, neighbors, caregivers, and strangers also commit elder abuse.

### Adults at Risk Services

Involves persons ages 18-59 with a diagnosed physical or mental impairment that substantially impairs the ability to care for his or her

needs that has experienced, is currently experiencing or is at risk of experiencing abuse, neglect, financial exploitation, or self-neglect to the degree to which their daily functioning is significantly impacted and their safety is in jeopardy.

### Guardianship

Chapter 54 of the Wisconsin Statutes governs the appointment of guardians for individuals found to be legally incompetent due to developmental disabilities, serious and persistent mental illness, degenerative brain disorders, or similar incapacities. A guardian may be appointed to make personal and medical decisions (guardian of the person) and/or manage financial affairs (guardian of the estate).

## ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES

### Term definitions:

**Adult Family Home (AFH):**  
A place where 3 or 4 adults who are not related to the operator reside and receive care, treatment or services that are above the level of

room and board and that may include up to 7 hours per week of nursing care per resident.

### *Community-Based Residential Facility (CBRF):*

A place where 5 or more unrelated people live together in a community setting. Services provided include room and board, supervision, support services, and may include up to 3 hours of nursing care per week.

### *Residential Care Apartment Complex (RCAC):*

Independent apartment units in which the following services are provided: room and board, up to 28 hours

per week of supportive care, personal care, and nursing services.
