

Famous is the story of Elijah who sought the Lord in a tumultuous season (1 Kings 19). A great wind rocked a mountain, then an earthquake, and then a great fire – but Elijah didn't find God amidst of any of those things until he quietly heard the Lord's voice in a gentle whisper. Assuredly the Lord's whisper brought him comfort, confidence, and clarity for a new direction. We need to hear that whisper now at Wesley.

Most are aware that on Sunday March 12 Wesley held a Special Church Conference for an official vote with Iowa Annual Conference District Superintendent, Rev. Michele Lundula presiding over the issue of our affiliation status. 74% of our membership present voted in favor of disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church and 78% voted in favor of joining the Global Methodist Church.

This was a significant step in our church's faith journey. Please pray for the gentle whisper to guide us through the next few steps.

To deliver on the collective decision of March 12, we will have to turn in requested documents, pay approximately \$113,000 of assessed pension liability and apportionment obligations, and receive disaffiliation approval from the Iowa Annual Conference which will be held June 2-4 in West Des Moines. In the meantime, our leadership at Wesley will be working on the application process to affiliate with the Global Methodist Church. We have legal representation from the National Center for Life and Liberty who will guide us in this process. I too will be working on a process in reference to my pastoral credentials and denominational membership status.

Prayerfully and hopefully, by July 1, 2023, if all things align well through the whirlwind of process, Wesley will be recognized officially as a Global Methodist Church, and I will be recognized as a fully ordained elder in the GMC continuing to serve as your pastor. Surely the presence of the Lord will supply renewed resolve and resource to build toward an exciting new future together.

April 9 is Easter after all! Is there anything more powerful and motivating than our great confirmed hope to fuel dynamic discipleship! Keep praying and keep listening for the Lord's voice.

### **Prayers in Deaths**


