



Last Sunday, April 23, I reminded everyone of the obvious, that we are in a time of transition. For me it feels something like the Exodus wilderness wanderings of God's people who have left something hard and challenging yet familiar, for something new and adventurously hopeful yet unfamiliar. The reassuring constant through it all, of course, is the cloud of God's presence that abides with us and guides us.

That's what the whole past few years have kind of built up to: dealing with all the challenges associated with the pandemic and then all the discussions and at times heated disagreements surrounding questions of disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church to contemplating affiliation with the Global Methodist Church. Now it feels we are at the water's edge of acting on the determined decisions and direction we have made. Let's do a brief review:

On September 18, 2022, by way of a special called Church Conference, a majority of members present voted to have the Administrate Council use ways and means to pursue disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church and seek affiliation with the Global Methodist Church. We have sent in our application to join the GMC as a charter member and as of Friday, April 21, we have received acknowledgement and approval for official membership, effective July 1, 2023.

In the meantime, our local transitional leadership will be preparing for a special "Wesley Covenant Service" that will inaugurate our new affiliation membership. The date of that service has yet to be determined.

Also on May 23, a Special Iowa Annual Conference will be held for a Conference vote on our disaffiliation from the UMC along with 78 other Iowa churches. Once likely approval takes place, within a few weeks thereafter, we will pay off all disaffiliation costs of \$115,133 with a \$150,000 loan from Wesley Investment Foundation. The remaining loan money will be used to purchase a new digital electronic sign in front of our property as well as for other aesthetic upgrades and for the removal of old signs.

More information regarding our membership status and process will be shared as soon as possible. Dear Wesley Church Family,

With the vote of the congregation on March 12 to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church and become affiliated with the Global Methodist Church, we would like to provide you with an update regarding the disaffiliation process.

Wesley's disaffiliation agreement was received from the Iowa Annual Conference and has been reviewed by NCLL, our legal representative, along with Ad Council. The final costs came in \$2,000 higher than the original estimate; our total costs will be \$115,133 paid to the Iowa Annual Conference in mid-June. Additional costs will be incurred for the removal of all United Methodist Cross and Flame insignias from our property. This transition provides a unique opportunity to replace and upgrade our existing street sign to promote our new affiliation with the Global Methodist Church.

A loan application has been submitted to the Wesleyan Investment Foundation for \$150,000 to cover all costs. The final loan amount will be adjusted based on special gifts received from YOU. *Please consider a special gift designated "disaffiliation costs"* in the near future.

Wesley's disaffiliation agreement documents will be submitted by the May 1, 2023 deadline.

The process to join the Global Methodist Church has been initiated.

Thank you for your continued faithfulness and support of Wesley.
