

Greetings of Peace and Renewed Hope!

On Tuesday, May 23, a Special Session to the Iowa Annual Conference was held via ZOOM media platform to decide upon the question of disaffiliation of 83 Iowa Conference churches, including Wesley. The motion passed by 96% and Wesley, along with the other 82 churches in question, will no longer be affiliated with the United Methodist Church effective June 30, 2023.

We are grateful to the lowa Annual Conference and its leadership for its graceful and prayerful tone in conducting these very sensitive proceedings. After hearing of controversies and of toxic political maneuvering in other conferences some were bracing for a mean-spirited debate in our own conference. It just did not happen like that in our case. We are humbly appreciative for the promised peace that was delivered.

Please continue to pray for all associated with this decision, to pursue God's pathway toward faithful witness and discipleship. Please also pray for Wesley concerning our next steps in our future affiliation with the Global Methodist Church, effective July 1, 2023.

Now we must work things out, in a time of transition, one step at a time in good faith. It may mean a bit of confusion and chaotic apprehension but in the end, I believe we will persevere and be stronger for it. Still ahead we need to deliver on disaffiliation costs, including signage issues.

We have secured a loan of \$150,000 to pay for immediate costs in the short term. In the short and long term, we anticipate lower costs of less apportionments to be paid to our new denomination as well as lower costs for health insurance coverage. Also, within the next month you will notice a few changes that may affect aesthetic preferences. You will notice the symbolic UMC flame behind the cross in the sanctuary and behind the large cross on the outside west wall of our church being removed due to legal and identification reasons. Also, our sign at the entrance to our parking lot will be taken down and replaced. It will be a new digital and lighted sign with our new Global Methodist logo on it.

As of July 1, we will now have complete ownership of our local facility. Of course, with new freedom of any kind comes greater responsibility.

We need the Body of Christ here locally to take greater responsibility in key areas: For an example are you **PRAYING DAILY** for our fellowship seeking renewed direction concerning our primary mission of making disciples of Christ? Are you **FULLY GIVING of your time, talent, treasure, and witness** to ensure the ministry here at Wesley is strong? If Wesley is God's calling for your investment – this is a critical time for you to really let your light shine! John Wesley, the founder of the early Methodist movement once said "give all you can" to ensure faithful witness. Please consider to **GIVE NOW**, beyond regular offerings at a critical time of renewed hope and purposeful direction. We need special time and talent resourcing in the areas of outreach and support of our **hospitality needs**, our **children and youth ministries**, our **music and worship needs**. We will be seeking new Spirt-filled, Biblically grounded, **mature leaders** to serve on the Administrative Council.

So many needs, but exciting is the opportunity to review from the ground up what God is calling us to become as a renewed expression of Methodist witness in our area. Please do not harden your heart to what He is leading the way for us to do! May our new affiliation on July 1 not be just a name change, but a genuine heart change for renewed opportunity to glorify God.
