

Now what? After surviving a pandemic that halted indoor services, then to accommodate a variety of worship provisions such as online video services only, to outdoor drive-in style services in the parking lot, to modified indoor services with masked and distancing rules, to gradually getting back to "normal" meet and greet services... FINALY at the end of 2021 we began to deal with a new kind of viral reality that has been brewing for some time in the background. We began discussing through sermons, simple conversations and printed article considerations the growing dissension and division in the United Methodist Church over issues surrounding sexuality, marriage, ordination, and core convictions over Biblical authority and doctrinal dispute. Then in early 2022 we had special guest speakers, representing opposing points of view to provide reasons why we at Wesley should consider leaving or staying with the UMC. In the spring of 2022, we had a series of small discussion groups and town-hall style meetings to try to inform our time of discernment. On September 18, 2022, we took an unofficial straw poll vote that resulted in 72% expressing that we should leave the United Methodist Church in favor of joining the new formed Global Methodist Church. Then, officially, on March 14 of this year we had a Special Church Conference that resulted in 74% affirming leaving the UMC for the GMC by July 1.

Guess what? It's July. It's official. We are now Wesley Global Methodist Church of Sioux City. Clearly, we have had quite a journey that has afforded us heartfelt and at times HARD-felt struggle. Through it all I believe it has caused us to really think and pray about our core convictions, values and aspirations concerning our discipleship and witness here in Siouxland. And the guestion for us now is... NOW WHAT?

First, I would suggest taking a pen and crossing out the first paragraph of my letter, not because we don't value historical reflection, but more to the point that now is the time to move on from the past. It's time to move on from previous discussing, debating, and discerning the issues of the past few years. It's time to joyfully move on to embrace a marvelous new adventure of living out our faith in association with a new denomination determined to pursue the higher ideals of a renewed Methodism. Now is the time to really focus on what we are for, rather than on what we stand against.


