Take it as it comes. Better yet, FAITH IT as it comes. The joyous exhilaration of the new, the lament of loss of the old, and the rush of decisions in the present can frustrate sound reflection and fruitful action. Good thing we have our faith in God's gracious presence, power, and perspective to rely on. Right! Right???

In the heat of change, our feelings often struggle to catch up with our faith. Don't they! That's why I appeal to all the Wesley faithful to keep meditating on what grounds us: "The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever." (Isaiah 40:8)

Good faith is grounded faith in the Word. This produces good fruit in us and all around us. And there currently is much going on all around us: amidst all the change we had a "Steller" Vacation Bible School experience in July. Thank you to our coordinator Christy Cook and the mix of renewed regular and new volunteers that brought a lot of fun-loving joy to our fellowship in a time of change.

Most have noticed the removal of old signs with our old logo and name on them. The large outside sign near the street will likely be replaced with a new digital sign, sometime in the fall. We have it ordered and are on the list to install it in a couple of months. The large "flame" in the sanctuary has been removed – yet there is the simplicity of the cross that remains to be appreciated. On the opposite side, in the upper SW corner of the sanctuary, a large temporary banner is in place with our new "Global Methodist Church" logo along with its mission statement to meditate upon this next month. It reads:

Our Mission is to make disciples of Jesus Christ who worship passionately, love extravagantly, and witness boldly.

The next few weeks we will try to unpack and understand the key values represented in this statement. I pray it becomes a living reality that grows from our grounding in the Word.

May the Spirit of God also spark a stronger connection with our sisters and brothers of Christ among the other Global Methodist Churches in our Siouxland area. Pray for Crescent Park, Trimble, Saint James, Riverside, Kingsley, and Anthon fellowships who also have traveled this road of affiliation change. Recently we promoted a combined service that was being planned for August 27, known as the "Siouxland Global Methodist Connection". That event has now been canceled due to scheduling conflicts and the expensive costs of different venue options. We have decided that this pause will give our area Global Methodist pastors more time to build on their relationships with one another before tackling a larger experience of a combined service together. Pray for the right timing for the right event in the future. Waiting is an expression of patient faith.
