The struggle for hope is real. At this writing there have been unexpected experiences of loss, grief, illness, personal injustice, interpersonal conflict, and great financial crisis happening among us at Wesley. And that's just in the last few weeks! As your pastor, I have consoled those who are experiencing profound pain in the surprising short-term - let alone the long-term routine struggles that have been lifted up for prayer that most of you have heard about. It all is very real and very frightful. Yet I implore you – do not lose sight of THE HOPE that we genuinely have in JESUS. Too easily we can forget who we are in Him by allowing despairing realities of the broken world to overshadow THE HOPE!

We live not in disillusionment! For OUR HOPE is MORE REAL than anything the world can throw at us. It is never a platitude to pacify to suggest such things as: "Greater is He that is in me than He that is in the world". Or "Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword... No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:35-39)

No need for platitudes, for our HOPE is real... grounded in HIStory – time and space. Luke affords us personal eyewitnesses to HOPE: "...they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, 'Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.' And they remembered his words..." (Luke 24:3-8)

So let us once again remember together concerning the HOPE. Lent removes disillusionment by way of the journey to the cross, and glory to God, it does not end in despair! Despite your personal struggle right now – embrace the HOPE in the scope of HIStory represented during...

March 24 is PALM SUNDAY, 9am and 11am - "When Facing Life and Death Issues"




