I had a surreal moment this morning. My A.I. "Artificial Intelligence" device known as "Alexa" rests on an end table in our living room. In the morning "she" awaits our usual request for a weather update for the day. Usually she offers accurate reporting, but sometimes she tries to offer a bit more information of potential influential interest if we grant permission to receive it. This morning, she offered something like, "Do you wish to receive your horoscope along with your weather report each morning?"

### I shouted "NO!!!"

For most orthodox Christians, deferring to horoscopes for any kind of direction in life is akin to mental and spiritual influences of an idolatrous and demonic nature. (See Deuteronomy 18:10-15). Long story short – the true believer in Christ is vigilant in what influences one's way of thinking and way for the day. It all begins with the mind: Thoughts beget actions and actions represent our character and values that inspire emotions and a sense of well-being in the Lord.

That's why Paul is so insistent that... "We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ." – 2 Corinthians 10:5. Clearly our greatest and ultimate source for true knowledge and foresight is the Word of God. Why even settle for or depend on anything else!

Wesley family, let us be distinct and mindfully different from the world of superficial dependency. Let us not be enamored with fly-by technology. Let us be focused on Biblically grounded theology – the study of God.

In mid- October we will offer a six Sunday sermon series, "Believer Basics"



focused on the essentials true believers of Christ need to know in their walk of faith. To supplement this pursuit of true knowledge I encourage meetings with Growth Groups either on Sunday morning between services at 10a.m. or on Wednesday nights here at the church at 6:30p.m.

These groups will be using Right Now Media resourcing featuring Francis Chan who will, in six sessions, focus on "Essentials of Faith" starting with Series 1: "What is a Christian?"

Persons wishing to go even deeper yet, there is a resource I am currently using with a few fellow disciples reading through together a book by Phil Tallon called "The Absolute Basics of the Christian Faith". If you would like to meet with me or on your own to go over each section, I would be glad to dis-

cuss the details. I have on my computer excellent videos that explain the book's content with artful graphics. There are ways to share. Let me know if interested.
