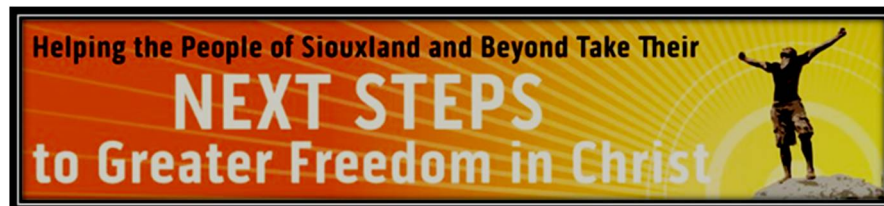

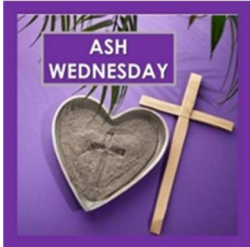

A simple service of Ash Wednesday will provide warmth for the soul with the imposition of ashes and Holy Communion offered as we begin this journey on March 5, 6:30 pm.

This year we will meditate on the Gospel according to Luke throughout the season of Lent. Books for daily meditation, written by Dr. Jim Miller, will be provided to enrich our understanding and application of the Gospel.

A description of the meditations that provide food for thought in preparation for our journey ahead is provided here:

"Jesus sums up the entire biblical message as follows: —You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself (Luke 10:27 NRSV). But what does that love look like where we live? Where we work? With the people we do life with everyday?

In answer to such questions, Dr. Jim Miller draws practical lessons from Luke's Gospel in order to help us live a life modeled after the example of Jesus Christ. This involves his pattern of prayer, relating to others, establishing holy priorities, and a host of day-to-day issues that together establish what Jesus himself called the abundant life."

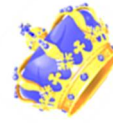
