After Paul spent about three years of ministry in Ephesus, he felt compelled of God to go elsewhere. He had so much Spirit-filled investment there and was grateful for so much that had happened there, and now God's timing and new opportunities motivated his departure from them.

To finish well he called the elders of Ephesus for a meeting to express endearment and to propel their greater ministry commitment after his departure. The historical event is recorded in Acts 20. Paul celebrated that, *"I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house to house, testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ... I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God."* (Vss. 20-21,27)

It's that simple. It's not about Paul. It's all about Jesus and His mission and ministry. We do well to have this same mindset as we at Wesley GMC transition to new pastoral leadership in the continued buildup of the Body of Christ here in its mission to simply promote *"repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ."*

Beth and I are confident that Pastor Scott and Karman Squires are of the same attitude and faith and will bless you with their God given gifts and graces to the glory of God. In the past few years especially, our friendship with them has grown and we know you will be blessed with a ministry couple who will exhibit beautifully, faithfulness in declaring *"the whole counsel of God"* (Vs.27) with the kindness and compassion of God.

It is good to know that God has provided you gifted new leadership as Beth and I will still be living here in Sioux City yet no longer as your pastoral couple, but forever as your friends in the Lord. Our last Sunday service before my retirement is one service only at 10am, with fellowship/potluck to follow, on Sunday June 29. We look forward to celebrating all the "next things" God has in store for all of us in a new season of ministry change.

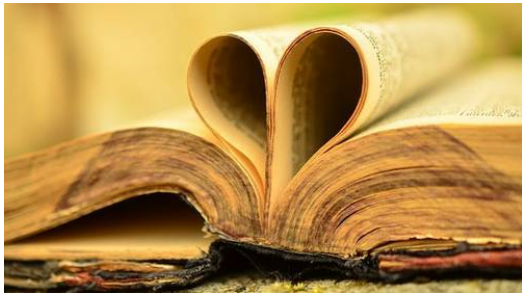
# Facts About Psalm 118

 Sewing Machine, Scissors, Cutting mats and rotary cutters, Quilting rulers

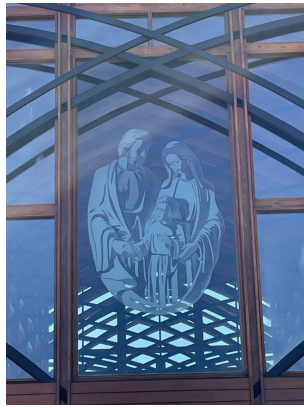
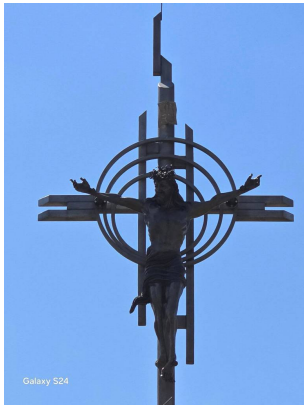
We have some of these things already donated, so if you don't have any, just come and we will put you to work! Remember, there are lots of jobs for non-sewers and hands on training will be given to get you started.
