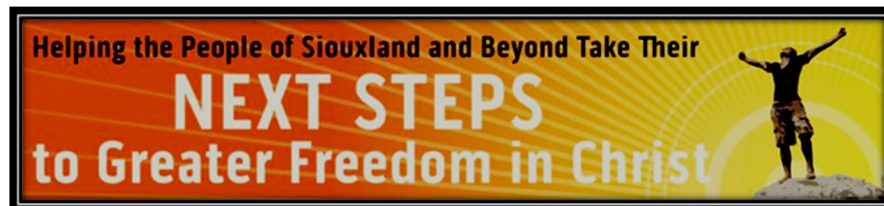

The combined Global Methodist Churches raised \$1300 for "Live for Him Ministries" during the Riverside Worship Service on Sunday, June 15th. That \$1300 will furnish 8,666 meals! John Battern was overwhelmed by your generous donation.

We hand delivered mission donations to two separate projects during the Upper Midwest Conference here in Sioux City on June 13-15, .

Wesley GMC raised \$261 for the Blessman Ministry's "Emergency Food Program" in South Africa. With some matching funds, that \$261 becomes \$522 to feed children daily!

Our church also raised \$156 for the Brightside Cafe in Sioux City. Brightside Cafe uses these funds for their "Feed it Forward" program which helps feed some of the homeless in downtown Sioux City.

Thanks for all you do and give throughout the year. We give out of the blessing we receive from God, to serve others locally and around the world.
