## League history

After getting wheelchair races added to the OHSAA state track meet in 2013, Adaptive Sports Ohio's next step was a school-based team sport for students with physical disabilities. Ohio Interscholastic Adaptive Sports wheelchair basketball teams are co-gender and consist of students in grades 1-12. Those who are home schooled, or who attend a private school or career center, are eligible to play in their local school district.

In 2015, Wooster City Schools formed the state's first school-based team, followed by Massillon City Schools the next year. In November 2016, Wooster and Massillon played the first interscholastic game, with the Generals winning 20-14 on the road, in the first of six games the teams contested that winter.

For the 2017-18 season, the league expanded to five teams, allowing for a full regular season and tournament. Wooster won the first OIAS state championship on its home floor, defeating Tallmadge 37-21. The Generals' Evan Heller led his team to three consecutive undefeated seasons, before going on to play wheelchair basketball for Auburn University and the U.S. men's under-23 national team. While the 2020 championship was completed just days before pandemic shutdowns began in Ohio, the next season was impacted, with three of the league's six school districts deciding not to play and the 2021 tournament being cancelled.

In 2022, the tournament final became a much bigger event, moving from high school gyms to large arenas, allowing a student-athlete experience worthy of a state championship, with video boards, a live stream with broadcasters, courtside seats for other teams, etc. In that season, Massillon and Wooster split their two regular-season meetings, with the Tigers ending Wooster's 53-game winning streak that dated back to the program's inception. At Kent State's MAC Center, the Generals came from behind to beat Massillon 23-17 in the final. The following year, Wooster won a 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive state title before the 2023 graduation of their three All-Ohio players who had been together since the very beginning.

With an All-Ohio trio of their own, Austintown rolled through the 2023-24 regular season undefeated, playing a free-flowing style behind senior sharpshooter Franklin Nicola, then the league's all-time career scoring leader. In the Akron Zips' Rhodes Arena, Tallmadge upset the Falcons in the state final, taking home their first championship. The Blue Devils capped an undefeated 2024-25 season by repeating as state champs.

## Summary of key rules

OIAS exists to provide opportunities for students with physical disabilities (not all of whom use wheelchairs on a day-to-day basis) to represent and compete for their schools. From its inception, the league has also included players without physical disabilities (often called "ABs", for "able-bodied"). To keep the focus where it belongs, there are limits on AB participation: at most five on a team roster, three dressed for each game, and two at a time on the court, with each limited to a maximum of 6 points in any contest. Categorization of athletes with physical disabilities was revised in 2022-23.

In 2025-26, a 20/10 mercy rule was added, as follows: When the score margin reaches 20+ points in the second half, the clock will run continuously, except for injuries or timeouts, and the leading team may have only one AB on the court. If the margin drops below 10 points, the clock continues to run but the usual two ABs are again allowed for the leading team.

A player with the ball may push their chair twice between dribbles or may keep dribbling while pushing their chair. There is no double-dribble violation in wheelchair basketball.

## Tournament structure

Given the relatively small number of teams, there has not yet been a need to subdivide into divisions by school enrollment. With the majority located in the greater Akron-Canton area, regional or conference play has not yet been instituted either. All participating teams move directly into one bracket for the single-elimination postseason tournament. To qualify, a team must play at least 12 regular-season games, or 10 in for those that are geographically isolated (the two Dayton-area teams.) The maximum number of regular-season games allowed is 15.

Following the OHSAA's move from seeding by coaches' votes to "computer" rankings, OIAS made a similar change in the 2023-24 season. The current system is modeled after the *wins above bubble* metric used in NCAA March Madness selection, comparing a team's actual record to that expected of a fairly strong team facing the same schedule. In 2025-26, updated rankings will be posted weekly on the league website.

Due to the league's geographic dispersion from Youngstown to Dayton, the timing of postseason tournament games is often dictated by the specific matchups, with long trips saved for Saturdays (potentially playing two games on the same day) and more local games perhaps on a weeknight. Since 2022, the state title game has been played in large college or professional basketball arenas.

## Players to watch in 2025-26

### Ta'Shaun Myers, Tallmadge junior forward

In leading the Blue Devils to a second consecutive state title, Myers had an electric sophomore campaign, breaking the single season scoring record with 284 points. With speed and skill that make him the league's most explosive player in transition, Myers is a favorite for player of the year. After the graduation of point guard Ben James, he has a chance to lead as an all-around player on offense and defense.

### Abby LaPole, Jackson senior center

The best post player in the league's history, LaPole is a game-changing presence at both ends of the floor. Facing frequent double-teams, she has the passing skills to find an open teammate. After taking the Polar Bears to the state final and winning player of the year, the only things left to accomplish are the career scoring record (likely) and a state title. LaPole was recently invited to the US women's national team tryout camp, which will occur mid-season.

### Zayne Hammoudeh, Green sophomore guard

After an outstanding debut as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, Hammoudeh was averaging 14 ppg last year until an unrelated injury cut his season short. The league's best pure athlete, he can score at all three levels but is effective when using his quickness to drive to the basket. Hammoudeh was recently selected for the 2026 US national team in wheelchair rugby, and this may impact his availability for interscholastic basketball games.

### Chris Good, Perry sophomore guard

From the time that he had a six-point game for Massillon in 2019, Good's potential has been clear. Last season was his best yet, averaging over 8 points per game as the primary scorer on a weak team. The Panthers may need even more from him this year, both as a scorer and as a playmaker.

### Ella Wirth, Wooster freshman forward

Taking a new role on a relatively young team, Wirth became the Generals' clear first option last year, scoring over 8 points per contest, and as many as 18 in a game. On a team that lost two starters, she will again be the offensive focal point.

## State championship game summaries

**2025: Tallmadge 41, Jackson 29** (MAC Center, Kent State)  
Top-seeded Tallmadge (17-0) won their 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive state championship, behind 25 points and 11 rebounds from sophomore Ta'Shaun Myers, who won the title game MVP award and broke the record for total points scored in a tournament, with 63 over three games. The Blue Devils forced 24 Polar Bear turnovers while committing just four. Holding a slim 30-26 lead after three quarters, Tallmadge pulled away late, with Myers scoring all 11 of his team's 4<sup>th</sup> quarter points. Athlete of the Year Abby LaPole kept second-seeded Jackson (13-3) in the game with 14 points on 5/13 shooting, while teammate Lucas Benson pulled down 15 rebounds. On a day when Myers' scoring required a high volume, shooting just 11/43 from the field, his three able-bodied teammates added 16 points on efficient 8/10 shooting.

**2024: Tallmadge 24, Austintown 16** (JAR Arena, U. of Akron)  
In their fourth trip to the state title game, Tallmadge (15-2) won their first championship in an upset of #1 Austintown (15-1). Freshman Ta'Shaun Myers led the Blue Devils with 16 points, while junior Ben James collected 10 rebounds and made all three of his shot attempts. However, the Tallmadge defense was the big story, holding the Falcons' potent offense to just 19% shooting. Austintown senior guard Franklin Nicola, who came in averaging a league-high 18 points per game, was held to just one field goal and 8 points total. With a relatively young team, Tallmadge broke the league's season record for scoring defense, giving up fewer than 12 points per game. While Austintown's three All-Ohio seniors came up just short of a state championship, they took the Falcons to the final in back-to-back seasons.

**2023: Wooster 18, Austintown 9** (MAC Center, Kent State)  
Wooster used a suffocating full-court press to win its 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive state title. In a game where both teams shot under 20% from the field, Wooster (14-0) had more than twice as many field goal attempts as Austintown (12-2), because of forcing 26 Falcon turnovers, most of them in the backcourt. Austintown's tight zone defense forced Wooster into tough perimeter shots, and all the Generals' points came from their three All-Ohio seniors, including 8 by Ryan Hannan. Wooster went through the tournament without allowing a point inside the arc, holding the Falcons to three 3-pointers and Jackson to two in the semifinal.

**2022: Wooster 23, Massillon 17** (MAC Center, Kent State)  
After Wooster and Massillon split their regular-season games, the Generals (13-1) prevailed in the state final over the Tigers (13-2) in yet another spirited contest. With freshman Nolan Hendricks' 11 points providing much of the Tiger scoring, Massillon was within one possession early in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Two baskets by Wooster junior Ryan Hannan, the latter an "and-one" in transition, helped the Generals pull away in the final period to win their 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive state championship. Earlier this season, Massillon beat Wooster 23-15 to snap the Generals' 53-game winning streak.

**2021: tournament cancelled** due to pandemic opt-outs

**2020: Wooster 45, Tallmadge 26** (Tallmadge HS)  
Wooster senior Evan Heller scored 19 of his game-high 27 points before halftime, including a pair of early 3s, as the Generals (17-0) defeated Tallmadge (13-4) in the state final for the third consecutive year. Sophomore Ashton Mohn added 12 for Wooster, while seniors Brennan Heavilin and Isaiah Johnson scored 13 and 9. The game marks the end of an era, with the upcoming graduation of the league's two brightest stars, Johnson and Auburn commit Heller, who are comfortably in the top two spots on the career scoring list.

**2019: Wooster 38, Tallmadge 12** (Massillon Washington HS)  
It was all Evan Heller in a repeat state title win for undefeated Wooster, as the Generals junior scored 28 points in the final, just hours after a 29-point performance in a semifinal victory over host Massillon. 8<sup>th</sup> grader Ryan Hannan added 8 points for Wooster, while Sammy Blatt led Tallmadge (10-4) with 6.

**2018: Wooster 37, Tallmadge 21** (Wooster HS)  
In a team-oriented contest where six players scored 6 or more points, Wooster (14-0) won the state's first interscholastic basketball championship over Tallmadge (10-4). After leading 21-12 at halftime, Wooster pulled away in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, when five different Generals scored as the lead increased to 17. The game's top scorer was the Generals' sophomore Evan Heller with 15 points, while Blue Devil sophomores Brennan Heavilin and Rory Murphy each accounted for 6.

## Notes on statistical records

This document is an attempt to compile the league's statistical history and records, to the degree that the underlying data exists. At the time of first compilation in 2025, official records (i.e. scorebooks) from some early contests had been lost. For others, only team scores and fouls were recorded, not individual scoring. For those games, attempts were made to obtain player scoring totals (and team scores, when missing) from the following alternative sources, in order of preference:

- 1) news articles (e.g. local newspapers)
- 2) school/team websites & social media accounts
- 3) other public social media posts (e.g. parents)
- 4) offline team records (e.g. coaches' notes)
- 5) offline records by others (e.g. parents)

After seeking information from all the above, we still lack individual scoring totals for 10-20% of games from 2018-2022, and nearly half from 2016-2018. As a result, early star players are likely under-ranked on the career scoring records lists.

Traditionally in high school (and other levels of) basketball, per-game scoring average is a preferred measure of offensive output. Until 2025, OIAS scorebooks did not contain a player participation category. In other words, for a player who did not score or commit a foul, there was no record of whether they entered a game, or even whether they were present. For this reason, we tend toward highlighting season scoring totals, rather than averages. Since top athletes are rarely shut out from scoring, in computing season scoring averages we assume that such players did not play in any game where they did not score, except in cases where we know otherwise.

In the absence of separate developmental (JV, middle school, etc.) teams, many athletes start playing for their schools while in elementary school, often while lacking the physical ability to shoot the ball over the rim. Some play for several years before scoring their first points. As a result, and because of the issues previously noted, we emphasize career scoring totals over career averages.

With the exception of the state championship game, other statistics (rebounds, assists, steals, etc.) are rarely recorded.
