Dear Parishioners,

- ◆ “Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat, but if it dies, it produces much fruit” (John 12: 24). Jesus speaks about the necessity of falling and dying to bear fruit.
- ◆ Tuesday, March 19, is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is one of the solemnities during Lent. Gloria is sung but not the Alleluia. St. Joseph was a just, virtuous, fervent, and righteous man. He was a silent figure in the scriptures. He had no speaking part. He didn’t say anything, not a word at the annunciation. He could have said something even just a simple assurance of ok, will do, got it, etc. The scriptures recorded none of that. He remained silent. Did he wrestle with the word of the angel? Absolutely. Was he perplexed with the incredible message? Of course. “For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived” (Mt. 1:20). And yet, he just went as instructed by angel Gabriel. Catholic Men should find inspiration in his life and example.
- ◆ Please be reminded of the Communal Penance Service on March 19, 2024, Tuesday. Praying, fasting and almsgiving along with the devotional practices of Lent should lead us to the Sacrament of Penance/Reconciliation. Confession is the fount of God’s mercy. There will be two confession times: 4:30pm and 6:30pm. The whole community is invited to confess our sins and seek forgiveness and truth to prepare for the grand celebration of Easter.
- ◆ Tuesday, March 19 is Spring Equinox. Bye Darkness! Hello Light! Welcome Spring! We’re glad you’re here. Our liturgies/religious services follow the seasons of the year and cosmic realities. They go with nature. They cannot be separated from God’s creation. Spring means life! Spring is the rebirth of nature. Spring brings new and fresh beginnings. Spring ushers renewal. Spring is the blossoming of the earth. Springtime is a turning point in life. Don’t miss it! Spring has sprung! Darkness is behind us. Light is upon us.
- ◆ Thank you, Steubenville Missionaries! Even if they only spent a few days here, the impact they left on the school is beyond words. I didn’t realize until recently it’s both ways. Spring Break for them has been spiritually rewarding. Coming to Loretto School for a week of mission is no joke. Dearest St. Lukes Family :

On March 4-6, 2024 Loretto Catholic School went through the accreditation process. The team that serviced our school was all from out of town. A team of 5 professionals came from as far as Oakland, California. They arrived Sunday and left on Wednesday evening. Superintendent Sheri Dahl came to receive the accreditation report from Assistant Superintendent Karen Goodshaw. The school was evaluated in four distinct domains and thirteen standards. The domains were Mission and Catholic Identity, Governance and Leadership, Academic Excellence, and Operational Vitality. The accreditation process is a six year process that culminates in the last two years. The last two years the school had to produce evidence for all four domains. The infinite collection of evidence presented by work samples, data, and many documents were stored in a data library. Standardized rubrics from Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA) were used to score the work and the evidence presented. We praise our Lord Jesus Christ for his presence and guidance in our school. The administration, staff, and parents evaluated the school in the first round and the accreditation team evaluated the school the second round. The accreditation team agreed with our score in eight standards and raised our score in four standards. We met benchmark in nine standards. This evaluation helped Loretto's leadership team to identify our next steps. The next steps are to increase parish and school parent engagement, building leadership capacity while forming and retaining teachers, creating and establishing professional learning community culture among faculty, and creating a five year growth plan and financial plan for the school. We are most appreciative and grateful to the most Holy Trinity for helping us grow into a great school! We also are thankful to Father Jojo, The Diocese of Tucson, the faculty and staff of Loretto, and the parents and students for helping us achieve exemplary marks on our accreditation

Querida familia de la Parroquia San Lucas

Del 4 al 6 de marzo de 2024, la Escuela Católica Loretto pasó por el proceso de acreditación. El equipo que atendió nuestra escuela eran todos de fuera de la ciudad. Un equipo de 5 profesionales vinieron desde lugares tan lejanos como Oakland, California. Llegaron el domingo y se marcharon el miércoles por la tarde. La superintendente Sheri Dahl vino a recibir el informe de acreditación de la superintendente adjunta Karen Goodshaw. La escuela fue evaluada en cuatro dominios distintos y trece estándares. Los dominios fueron Misión e Identidad Católica, Gobernanza y Liderazgo, Excelencia Académica y Vitalidad Operacional. El proceso de acreditación es un proceso de seis años que culmina en los últimos dos años. Los últimos dos años la escuela tuvo que presentar pruebas para los cuatro dominios. La colección infinita de evidencia presentada por muestras de trabajo, datos y muchos documentos se almacenó en una biblioteca de datos. Se utilizaron rúbricas estandarizadas de la Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA) para calificar el trabajo y la evidencia presentada. Alabamos a nuestro Señor Jesucristo por su presencia y guía en nuestro colegio. La administración, el personal, y los padres evaluaron la escuela en la primera ronda, el equipo de acreditación evaluó la escuela en la segunda ronda. El equipo de acreditación estuvo de acuerdo con nuestro puntaje en ocho estándares y aumentó nuestro puntaje en cuatro estándares. Cumplimos con el punto de referencia en nueve estándares. Esta evaluación ayudó al equipo de liderazgo de Loretto a identificar nuestros próximos pasos. Los próximos pasos son aumentar la participación de los padres de la parroquia y la escuela, desarrollar la capacidad de liderazgo mientras se forma y retiene a los maestros, crear y establecer una cultura comunitaria de aprendizaje profesional entre los profesores y crear un plan de crecimiento de cinco años y un plan financiero para la escuela. ¡Estamos muy agradecidos con la Santísima Trinidad por ayudarnos a convertirnos en una gran escuela! También estamos agradecidos al Padre Jojo, a la Diócesis de Tucson, al cuerpo docente y al personal de Loretto, y a los padres y estudiantes por ayudarnos a lograr calificaciones ejemplares en nuestra acreditación.






