Dear Parishioners,

- ◆ This Sunday, the 4th Sunday of Easter is also known as the Good Shepherd Sunday to stress this lovely image of the risen Christ as the Good Shepherd who says, *“I am the gate for the sheep who calls each of us by name”*. Let me quote the following inspiring gospel verses: *“the sheep hear his voice...the sheep follow him because they recognize his voice...I came so that they might have life and have it abundantly”*. We, the sheep, the people of God, and the faithful are hearing so many voices claiming for the truth and the common good. Since we belong to the Good Shepherd, we must remain together, united under Leo XIV as a global community founded on faith whose voice under Leo drawn from the life, example and teachings of Christ and the church that represents the Lord is understandably different from the world, society and politics.
- ◆ This Sunday is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We especially take a moment to pray for vocations in the catholic community. We should create a spiritual environment and a culture that promotes and encourages vocations to priesthood and religious life modeled after the Good Shepherd.
- ◆ On Sunday, May 3, there will be a May Crowning led by the Religious Education Program First Communicants with the recitation of the rosary at 3:00 pm, offering of flowers and crowning of Mary to honor her as Queen of Heaven. This will be followed by Mass at 4:00 pm. May Crowning is a popular devotion during springtime with the blossoming of the earth and reawakening of creation.
- ◆ During Easter Season, we recite the Regina Caeli Prayer in place of the Angelus at 6:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 6:00 pm.

Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia. The Son whom you merited to bear, alleluia, has risen as he said, alleluia. Pray for us to God, alleluia. V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia. R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray.

O God, who have been pleased to gladden the world by the Resurrection of your Son our Lord Jesus Christ, grant, we pray, that through his Mother, the Virgin Mary, we may receive the joys of everlasting life. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

- ◆ During the Easter Season, we replace the Stations of the Cross with the Stations of the Resurrection, that is, Via Lucis or Way of Light.

- ◆ Este domingo, el cuarto domingo de Pascua, también se conoce como el Domingo del Buen Pastor para enfatizar esta hermosa imagen de Cristo resucitado como el Buen Pastor que dice: *"Yo soy la puerta de las ovejas que nos llaman a cada uno por su nombre"*. Permítanme citar los siguientes versículos inspiradores del evangelio: *"las ovejas escuchan su voz... las ovejas le siguen porque reconocen su voz... Vine para que tuvieran vida y la tuvieran en abundancia"*. Nosotros, las ovejas, el pueblo de Dios y los fieles, estamos escuchando tantas voces que reclaman la verdad y el bien común. Dado que pertenecemos al Buen Pastor, debemos permanecer unidos, unidos bajo León XIV como una comunidad global fundada en la fe cuya voz bajo León extraída de la vida, el ejemplo y las enseñanzas de Cristo y la iglesia que representa al Señor es comprensiblemente diferente del mundo, la sociedad y la política.
- ◆ Este domingo es el Día Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones. Especialmente nos tomamos un momento para orar por vocaciones en la comunidad católica. Debemos crear un entorno espiritual y una cultura que promueva y fomente las vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa modeladas según el Buen Pastor.
- ◆ El domingo 3 de mayo habrá una Coronación de mayo liderada por el programa de educación religiosa, primero comulgantes, con la recitación del rosario a las 3 pm, la ofrenda de flores y la coronación de María para honrarla como Reina del Cielo. A continuación habrá misa a las 4 pm. La coronación de mayo es una devoción popular durante la primavera, con el florecimiento de la tierra y el reavivamiento de la creación.
- ◆ Durante la temporada de Pascua, recitamos la Oración de Regina Celi en lugar del Ángelus a las 6:00 am, 12:00 pm y 6:00 pm.

Reina del cielo, alégrate, aleluya. El Hijo que merecías llevar, aleluya, ha resucitado como dijo, aleluya. Ruega por nosotros a Dios, aleluya. V. Alégrate y alegraos, oh Virgen María, aleluya. R. Porque el Señor ha resucitado verdaderamente, aleluya.

Oh Dios, que has querido alegrar al mundo con la Resurrección de tu Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, concede, te rogamos, que por su Madre, la Virgen María, podamos recibir las alegrías de la vida eterna. Por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén.
