Dear Parishioners,

- ◆ On the 5th Sunday of Easter, Thomas' question is worth pondering, *"Lord, we don't know where you are going. So how can we know the way?" (John 14: 5)*. This was the time when the disciples had the difficult time accepting and coming to terms with Jesus' impending departure for good. There was uncertainty about the future and the ideals. May is a time of departure (permanent and temporary) from school/schoolwork either for leisure or next chapter of life. Jesus didn't leave us the blueprint, the complete road map or the manual about what to do exactly at a given situation with every single tiniest details. None of that. There was no writing left behind except with a finger on the sand. The first few decades were spent in oral tradition that is, by word of mouth, fresh from the mouth of the apostles known as apostolic tradition. There were no sacred writings as a basis and guide in critical decision making. They only had to rely on his words that is, fidelity to the gospel message – *"I am the way, and the truth and the life. No one comes to the father except through me" (John 14: 6)*.
- ◆ This Sunday, May 3, we will celebrate **May Crowning** to honor Mary as Queen of Heaven led by the religious education program first communicants with the recitation of the rosary at 3:00 pm, offering of flowers and crowning of Mary, followed by Mass at 4:00 pm.
- ◆ In conjunction with America250, Msgr. Greg Adolf will make a presentation on the history of the Catholic Church in Cochise County with the title, **Our Story: The Church in Southern Arizona**. Please mark your calendars on Thursday, June 25, 2026, 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm, St. Luke Church.
- ◆ In anticipation of the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and #America250, we will hold a Novena from June 3 – 11, 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm, St. Luke Church. As we look forward to Friday, June 12, we will once again reflect on the apostolic exhortation of Pope Francis, *Dilexit Nos* (He loved us). We will join parishes nationwide in consecration churches to the sacred heart of Jesus.
- ◆ #America250, our 3 parishes, will hold 250 hours of adoration, from June 3-11. #America250, we can start reflecting on the contributions of Catholics in our community.
- ◆ There will be novena for **Father's Day**, from June 12-20, St. Luke Church. Preparations for Father's Day dinner and dance on Saturday, June 20, 6:00 pm – 7:30 pm are also underway.

Estimados feligreses,

- ♦ El quinto domingo de Pascua, la pregunta de Tomás merece ser meditada: "*Señor, no sabemos a dónde vas. ¿Cómo podemos saber el camino?*" (Juan 14:5). Fue en ese momento cuando los discípulos tuvieron dificultades para aceptar y aceptar la inminente partida definitiva de Jesús. Había incertidumbre sobre el futuro y los ideales. Mayo es un momento de despedida (permanente y temporal) de la escuela/estudios, ya sea por ocio o por la siguiente etapa de la vida. Jesús no nos dejó el plano, la hoja de ruta completa ni el manual sobre qué hacer exactamente en una situación dada, con cada detalle más pequeño. Nada de eso. No quedaba nada escrito salvo con un dedo en la arena. Las primeras décadas las pasaron en la tradición oral, es decir, de boca en boca, recién salida de la boca de los apóstoles, conocida como tradición apostólica. No existían escritos sagrados como base y guía en la toma de decisiones críticas. Solo tenían que confiar en sus palabras, es decir, en la fidelidad al mensaje del evangelio – "*Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie viene al padre sino por mí*" (Juan 14:6).
- ♦ Este domingo 3 de mayo celebraremos **la Coronación de mayo** para honrar a María como Reina del Cielo, guiados por el programa de educación religiosa que primero comunican con la recitación del rosario a las 3 pm, la ofrenda de flores y la coronación de María, seguida de misa a las 4 pm.
- ♦ En colaboración con America250, Mons. Greg Adolf hará una presentación sobre la historia de la Iglesia Católica en el condado de Cochise con el título, **Nuestra historia: La Iglesia en el sur de Arizona**. Por favor, marque su calendario el jueves 25 de junio de 2026, de 6 a 7 pm, en la iglesia de San Lucas.
- ♦ En previsión de la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y #America250, celebraremos una Novena del 3 al 11 de junio, de 18:00 a 19:00, en la iglesia de San Lucas.
